EXODUS 12; 7

HYSSOP

Unleavened bread – for the journey
Remember when you left Egypt.
Remember when Abraham crossed
over and left his family and traveled in
the land where God led him.
For us today remember when you left
the things of the world behind.
Leaven can mean more than sin, it can
also mean the things of the world.

And a mixed multitude went up also with them;
and flocks, and herds, even very much cattle.
