
You Might Call Me A Heretic But...

Isaiah 41 ; 26 - 42;8 Who hath declared from the beginning, that we may know? and beforetime, that we may say, He is righteous? yea, there is none that sheweth, yea, there is none that declareth, yea, there is none that heareth your words. The first shall say to Zion, Behold, behold them: and I will give to Jerusalem one that bringeth good tidings.

For I beheld, and there was no man; even among them, and there was no counsellor, that, when I asked of them, could answer a word. Behold, they are all vanity; their works are nothing: their molten images are wind and confusion.

Behold my servant, whom I uphold; mine elect, in whom my soul delighteth; I have put my spirit upon him: he shall bring forth judgment to the Gentiles. He shall not cry, nor lift up, nor cause his voice to be heard in the street.

A bruised reed shall he not break, and the smoking flax shall he not quench: he shall bring forth judgment unto truth. He shall not fail nor be discouraged, till he have set judgment in the earth: and the isles shall wait for his law.

What about Acts 2?

What did Peter really say to convince all of those people to believe? What would have happened to Peter if he had presented Yeshua as **הוה**? Tradition and church doctrine use Acts 2;21 as a stand alone verse - And it shall be, that whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved. This is the quote from Joel - Whoever calls on the name הוה will be saved

Acts 2;40 And with many other words did he testify and exhort, saying, Save yourselves from this untoward generation. We don't have all of the information in this passage John 19;35 And he that saw it bare record, and his record is true: and he knoweth that he saith true, that ye might believe.

What did John see?

1 John 5;8 And there are three that bear witness in earth, the Spirit, and the water, and the blood: and these three agree in one.

The purpose of the crucifixion is to provide the perfect blood as a final atonement for violating the covenant confirmed by blood at Mount Sinai when Moses poured blood on the alter and then sprinkled blood on the people

What is the purpose of the resurrection?

Matthew 12;39-40 But he answered and said unto them, An evil and adulterous generation seeketh after a sign; and there shall no sign be given to it, but the sign of the prophet Jonas: For as Jonas was three days and three nights in the whale's belly; so shall the Son of man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth.

Psalm 110;1 The Lord said unto my Lord, Sit thou at my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool.



And righteousness shall be the girdle of his loins, and faithfulness the girdle of his reins.

Revelation 19; 11 - 13 And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war. His eyes were as a flame of fire, and on his head were many crowns; and he had a name written, that no man knew, but he himself. And he was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and his name is called The Word of God.

Jeremiah 23; 5 - 6 Behold, the days come, saith the Lord, that I will raise unto David a righteous Branch, and a King shall reign and prosper, and shall execute judgment and justice in the earth. In his days Judah shall be saved, and Israel shall dwell safely: and this is his name whereby he shall be called, The Lord Our Righteousness.

Is Yeshua **הוה**? Not yet... Mark 13;32/Matthew24;36 - But of that day and that hour knoweth no man, no, not the angels which are in heaven, neither the Son, but the Father.

Revelation 22; 1-4 And he shewed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of God and of the Lamb. In the midst of the street of it, and on either side of the river, was there the tree of life, which bare twelve manner of fruits, and yielded her fruit every month: and the leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations. And there shall be no more curse: but the throne of God and of the Lamb shall be in it; and his servants shall serve him: And they shall see his face; and his name shall be in their foreheads.

Psalm 17;15 As for me, I will behold Your face in righteousness; when I awake, I will be satisfied in Your presence. Psalm 23;6 Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the house of יהוה forever.

Why is it so important to know Yeshua for who he is? Because knowing who Yeshua really is helps us understand who **h**is. Knowing who Yeshua is prevents us from replacing **hin** Knowing who Yeshua really is and what he did for us as a human being is our perfect example that we don't need to be God to love our neighbor as ourself. Knowing who Yeshua is as a human being means we are capable of doing the things he did

ADDENDUM

No one **asked** about Isaiah 42; 7, who are the prisoners he sets free?

Isaiah 42;7 To open the blind eyes, to bring out the prisoners from the prison, and them that sit in darkness out of the prison house.

1 Samuel 2;6 יהות killeth, and maketh alive: he bringeth down to the grave, and bringeth up

Revelation 1;18 I am he that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; and have the keys of hell and of death.

What greater prison to be released from in our future other than death?

Yeshua makes the statement he was dead, can is not be the same as יהוה because יהוה is not capable of being "dead". Yeshua will act as יהוה צדקנו (Righteous Yehovah) on earth. He has died and was resurrected and holds the keys to the place of the dead. tells us he is verything the Father יהוה tells us he is and he is not what man attempts to force him to

be.
