

Due to the drastic upsurge in Zoom users during the Coronavirus scare, the software company has tightened their online security to prevent eavesdropping and unsanctioned entry into Zoom sessions. As a result, I've removed our meeting ID from our web site, and there is now a required password to enter a meeting.

I have set our password to 801315. You'll note that this is the first six numbers of our Meeting ID (8013155768).

To enter the meeting click on your Zoom icon and then on "Join A Meeting". When you click on "Join A Meeting" you are asked to enter the "Meeting ID". Enter 8013155768 and press Join. You will then be asked to "Enter Meeting Password". Enter 801315, press Enter, and you will be directed to our Fellowship. The computer will then prompt you to "Join With Video" or "Join Without Video". Select this option based on whether you have a camera on your computing device.

Again, I've written a lot, but the only change is that you need to enter the password (801315) to gain access to the meeting.

I will publish times on Sunday for testing your system with a live meeting during next week. Watch your email for those dates and times so that we can work out any issues with your system prior to next Shabbat.
