Adding the longer segment that visits the Sukkot Stone and Tayma also adds another \$397 to the air costs because flying out of Al Ula is more expensive than Aqaba. By joining this tour, you have an exclusive opportunity to study the land and inspect its evidence with remarkable adventure and educational intrigue! Explore Midian, known by locals to be the homeland of Jethro (the prophet named Shu'ayb), who was Moses' father-in-law. Examine the Split Rock of Horeb at Jabal Maqla, where Moses struck the boulder and God miraculously provided water from within. Survey the Jabal al-Lawz mountain, with its charred and blackened summit ascertained to be the original Mount Sinai which Yahweh descended upon in fire. Discover for yourself why Jewish and Bedouin traditions have continued for centuries to call this peak "The Mountain of Moses." Take this afternoon together to research and uncover fresh discoveries in and around the mountain or Midian.

If you have extra time and funds, adding both or one of the optional extensions is a lifetime opportunity. Diving in the Red Sea? Either are great opportunities and traveling with these two educators will add to your depth of knowledge and your ability to return home and share the amazing things that Yahweh has done for us to see in our lifetime. Our optional extension to the Sukkot Stone, sleeping near it on the last night of Sukkot will be something to treasure forever.

Both Pam and Tommy have traveled to Saudi Arabia a couple of times each, and during each trip, they find many more exciting archaeological finds that they want to share with fellow believers and explorers, here is your opportunity! On their last trip, they were able to see a 5,000-year-old Egyptian boat carved adjacent to a proto-Hebraic inscription AND they were able to take samples of soils at what may be kilns, stoves, and molds just next to the encampment of the main Exodus site where both Moses Altar and the Altar to the Golden Calf are located.

This trip has a lot of firsts, and you will also have the opportunity for even more discovery with our TWO-night optional camp nights at the foot of Jabal al-Lawz. Camping is not mandatory; we have it set up for those looking for a bit more adventure. We normally only offer camping for 1 night but for this particular group, you can opt to have two fabulous nights of fellowship with Mount Sinai looming overhead. **Be a part of history!**

DR. TOMMY COLIE, *Pastor*

Dr. Tommy Colie is an instructor of Religion and a pastor of Brogden Chapel Church in North Carolina. He is also a representative of Bridges for Peace in North Carolina, an organization that supports Israel and the Jewish people. Tommy has been through the Exodus route twice and will be on a third archeological endeavor prior to the October expedition that takes place in October 2024. He is also a short-term missionary, having traveled to over 25 countries. While he may seem an amateur biblical archaeologist/Exodus explorer – he has been integral in finding artifacts on four different continents. Tommy also has a BS in Criminal Justice from East Carolina, a Master's in Religion from Liberty University, and a doctorate in Theology from Potters House Seminary. His hobbies are scuba/shark diving, skydiving, traveling, rock climbing, and and other adventure sports.



PAM LAURION

Pamela Laurion a former educator and a judicial consultant for the State of Delaware, has taught Hebrew studies and ancient Hebrew script for the past 15 years to various congregations throughout Delaware. Because she was fascinated with Mount Sinai and the Split Rock archeological sites in Saudi Arabia, she traveled with Living Passages to visit the sites in 2020 returning to Saudi Arabia several more times. Pam was able to photograph and document new discoveries and teach about the newly discovered inscriptions and artifacts. Recently Pam's discoveries at these sites were presented to a team at The Museum of the Bible in Washington D.C. and for the past 3 years, she has traveled and presented her experiences nationwide. Pam's travels throughout the Middle East- Egypt, Jordan, Israel, and Saudi Arabia give her a wide knowledge base for the archeological sites in the Exodus story. In addition, Pam teaches regularly at her Messianic Fellowship. Pam believes the Saudi Arabian sites for Mount Sinai (Jabal al-Lawz) and the Split Rock at Horeb, are arguably some of the most important archeological sites in the world.

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OPTIONAL PETRA OR RED SEA DIVING EXTENSION ITINERARY-AT-A-GLANCE

October 12/13: Depart Dulles on October 12 on Turkish Air at 10:20PM, and change planes in Istanbul.

October 14: Crossing the dateline, we arrive in Aqaba at 1:10AM on Turkish Air, and transfer to Red Sea hotel and dive resort. Free day with a welcome huge seafood dinner in Aqaba. Overnight Aqaba.

October 15: Diving the Red Sea, take a "try a dive" or a take the tour of Petra, overnight Aqaba.

October 16: Free day or diving included, after dinner, we visit the promenade in Aqaba and then transfer into Saudi Arabia for overnight.

October 17: Main tour guests will arrive hotel around 3:00AM. We will have breakfast together and begin the tour with a first visit to the Split Rock.



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MOUNT SINAI EXPEDITION ITINERARY-AT-A-GLANCE

October 15/17: Depart Dulles to Aqaba on Turkish Air at 10:20PM.

October 16: Crossing dateline, 5-hour layover in Istanbul.

October 17: Arrive in Aqaba at 1:10AM early morning, transfer to a Red Sea hotel in Saudi Arabia. After a late breakfast, we drive to the Split Rock of Horeb with the battleground of the Amalekites.

October 18: Elim (site of the quail miracle), Midian, the Well of Moses, the Caves of Jethro.

October 19: The encampment of the Springs of Moses, Jabal al-Lawz! Inscriptions of God's warriors under the blackened rock. Optional two-night camping in view of Mount Sinai.

October 20: Those wishing to hike Mount Sinai do so this morning. Climb can include the Plateau of the 70 Elders, Elijah's Cave, and the blackened top of Jabal Maqla. Non-climbers visit Aynounah – the burial ground of Abraham's Generations, the Altar of Moses, the Cemetery of the 3,000 slain of Exodus, the cleansing streambed, and the pillars of the 12 Tribes of Israel.

October 21: Another breakfast at camp. Visit the Altar to the Golden Calf. Visit sites of the potential chimneys and mold formations. Time for exploration for evidence and documenting camp placement of the 12 Tribes of Israel. Bedouin lunch with the locals. Late in the afternoon, we drive to a new and important site with a 5,000-year-old Egyptian boat inscription with at least one ancient Hebrew inscription. Return to the Red Sea hotel for dinner and overnight.



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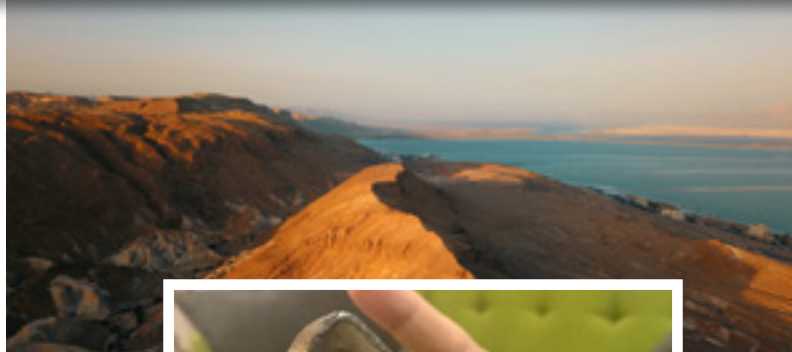
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MOUNT SINAI EXPEDITION ITINERARY-AT-A-GLANCE

October 22: Rest this morning at the hotel and have a time of fellowship and worship together at the beach. Morning visit to the crossing site of the Exodus facing Nuweiba Beach. Drive back into Jordan. Drive for 3 hours and have a nice dinner on the Jordanian side of the Dead Sea (great view of Israel). Visit Mount Nebo in Jordan and then transfer to the airport for your flights home.

October 22: We wake up in Tabuk this morning and drive to Tayma (Tema, Tiamat, Taima) - where Abraham's son Ishmael's son Tema lived. Our target is inscriptions, the cemetery, and the palace of Nabonidus (of the Book of Daniel) father to Belshazzar. Finish our day late this evening near Al Ula at Biblical Dedan.

October 23: Today we will visit the famous caves of Al Ula and Hegara and then return to Dedan to the highly unique stone that Michael C.A. Macdonald states "was accepted as a harvest right parallel to the Jewish Sukkoth or "Festival of Booths". Closeout Sukkot at sunset and visit Elephant Rock in the evening.

October 24: Today we drive to Khaybar to see the Masada of Arabia that was built by the ruling families of the Hejaz - the Jewish Priestly Tribes. It was vacated very similar to Masada. Return to Al Ula overnight.

October 25: Breakfast and flight at 11:25AM to Al Ula to Riyadh. 7-Hour layover in Riyadh and then return flights from Riyadh to Istanbul and back to the USA.

October 26: Arrive Dulles at 12:10PM.

IMPORTANT TRAVEL DETAILS

Our trip is considered active on two days in Saudi Arabia and one to two days in Jordan. This means that, if you choose to hike (or climb), two days will offer ample time. If you are not a hiker, just know that walking is on fairly normal surfaces. You do not need to climb up Mount Sinai or sit inside the Split Rock of Horeb to enjoy the sites. There are some hikes and climbs, more demanding walks at certain sites, or when walking to sites. This includes a few elevations, a comfortable but busy schedule, some long rides, and extensive drives. Our primary hotel on the Red Sea is a brand new, lovely privately owned hotel with spectacular views. Should we need to stay in Tabuk to accommodate your air, it will be a 4-star Western-style hotel with all amenities. The resort near Aqaba (if you choose the dive or Petra extension) is a simple Red Sea front resort with easy access and it is small and intimate enough to meet our needs for fellowship without getting lost in a huge complex. Note the Saudis reserve the right to always change our hotels, so we cannot be responsible should they decide to place us in another property. You also have the option of spending one-night camping at the base of Jabal al-Lawz. 60% of all transportation is in Toyota Land Cruisers or equivalent. All the services meet our high standards, and you will be very comfortable and pleased. We obtain a visa on your behalf approximately 32 days before departure. You may also obtain your visas on your own. Your trip in Saudi Arabia includes hotels, ALL meals, and water on the entire trip. It includes the 4WD transportation and all transportation throughout the trip, all entrance fees, guiding, highly specialized permits, teaching, pre-trip materials, and visa assistance. Please note that in addition to the cost of the tour, there is a visa fee and optional trip cancellation insurance. We strongly recommend trip cancellation insurance which includes medical insurance while outside of the USA and trip delay protection included, etc. We also can offer an upgraded program that allows you to "Cancel for Any Reason". Email us for a quote!

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TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Proper Documentation

All members of this tour must carry passports valid for at least six months beyond their scheduled date of return. At this time there are no Covid requirements for Saudi Arabia – no PCR tests and no injections. But, please note that things can also change. At this time, we have no way of knowing what could be implemented in the future. Please note that the vendors will have already accepted your booking knowing there is a current global threat. Therefore, if you book this tour, you are accepting the terms of the airlines, the TSA, the countries to which you are traveling and/or other governing parties without fully knowing what they will be by the time you travel.

Air Tickets

There is an air block that originates from Washington, Dulles to Aqaba, Jordan on Turkish Air, roundtrip. Keep in mind, you may find a far more convenient schedule on your own utilizing Turkish Air from other cities. They fly from numerous cities including Seattle, San Francisco, Los Angeles, Chicago, Houston, Dallas, New York, Atlanta, Miami, etc. You may also fly into Tabuk, Saudi Arabia and we can transfer you to the group. Add \$260 per car for each private transfer to the Red Sea area where we are staying (each way). Business class is usually around \$2,500 to \$3,300 more per person than economy class.

The current air schedule (ALWAYS subject to change) is below that you can book on your own, or match for flight arrival and departure transfers to be included:

The main departure for the Saudi Air expedition only will depart Washington, Dulles (you can also leave from any Turkish Air gateway, if you purchase your own tickets) on October 15 on TK #8 at 10:20PM, nonstop to Istanbul, arriving at 3:30PM. Layover until 8:55PM, and arrive Aqaba in Jordan on TK #832 at 1:10AM.

The return flights depart Aqaba on October 23, departing Amman, Jordan on TK #813 at 2:15AM, arriving Istanbul at 4:40AM, then departing Istanbul on TK #187 at 8:20AM and arriving Washington, Dulles at 12:10PM.

Those taking the post-extension to the Sukkot Stone and to Tayma and Khaybar will depart the city of Al Ula October 25 on Saudi Arabian Airlines #1578 at 3:50PM, 6 hour layover in Riyadh and then change to TK #141 at 1:10AM, arriving Istanbul at 5:35AM and then depart on TK #187 at 8:20AM, arriving Washington, Dulles at 12:10PM on October 26.

Reissuance of tickets that must be changed or reissued for any reason may be subject to charges or fees by the carriers and/or other vendors; such fees may be substantial. Saudi Airlines can change their air schedules at any time, and sometimes without notification. We cannot stress enough the importance of trip cancellation insurance. Due to the current situation arising with struggling airlines, we are recommending that those purchasing airline tickets including connecting flight tickets wait until 21 days prior to departure to purchase such tickets.

Limitations

The air carrier(s), group operators, and LP reserve the right to substitute equipment and properties and to add or delete en route stops at our discretion with or without notice. The hotels, airlines, ground operators, and other vendors used by LP reserve the right, in special circumstances, to substitute accommodations/transportation and sights of similar or better quality without penalty. This includes sites as noted on the itinerary. The KSA is in its infancy. Because of this – they can choose to do site work that can affect our visits. The minimum group size is 14, and with less than 16, the pricing could increase as high as 10%. We will do everything we can to avoid any increases.

Singles

We match roommates! If you are a single person or traveling alone, we do have others who would like to travel with us without paying the single supplement. We assign

roommates approximately 2 weeks prior to departure. We cannot guarantee it, but it has worked well for many.

Making Your Deposit / Reservations

- If depositing prior to June 30, 2024, a non-refundable deposit of \$750 per person is due (plus optional travel insurance) and your signed registration form. If booking after June 30, 2024 - full payment is due within 7 days of your registration.

Payments not received by the due day are subject to a 5% monthly finance charge and possible cancellation of the reservation.

- Please note we will continue to take bookings and reservations until our departure, as long as space is available, and we will do everything possible to make sure you can join us!
- You may use a credit card for your initial deposit and optional insurance and then pay the balance with cash or check and still receive the full cash discount.

Changes / Revisions

We will try to accommodate name changes, but additional fees may be imposed and passed on by the carriers. If specific rooming requests are altered due to cancellation by one or more passengers, the passenger(s) still traveling may be required to pay the resulting applicable occupancy rate. Trip insurance may cover this additional cost.

Cancellation and Refunds

In the event that you must cancel your reservation, or payments are not received by specified deadlines, refunds are made in accordance with the following schedule. All cancellations received after booking and deposit will forfeit the \$750 deposit.

- 68 to 45 days prior to departure, the cancellation fee is \$2450 for the main tour per person, plus any additional costs incurred pre- or post-options, and insurance or add-on travel you have purchased.
- 44 days and less the trip becomes nonrefundable. Please know that credits transferred from another tour are subject to the nonrecoverable costs in place at the time of transfer. These funds will remain nonrefundable. If you accept the travel insurance offered, any insurance premium paid is nonrefundable, if you have filed a claim, plan to file a claim, or have departed on your trip and subject to the terms and conditions of the provider. Airfare is always non-refundable.

is determined by their government – if they have specific reasons to change us. Activities

Participants may choose to engage in various activities including, but not limited to, climbing, camel riding, 4-wheeling, hiking, swimming, and other "activities"; participants are hereby notified that these and other activities may be dangerous and may result in serious injury and that participation in these activities shall be at the participant's own risk. Living Passages (herein referred to as LP) shall not be liable for any injuries sustained by cruise/tour participants, which are a result of participants engaging in such activities.

Travelers Who Need Special Assistance

LP must be advised of a participant's special requirements at the time of booking and we will make every effort to accommodate special requests but cannot confirm a reservation until all travel suppliers have acknowledged that they can provide the services requested.

Prepaid Tips

In Saudi Arabia, all tips are prepaid and distributed on your behalf throughout the tour to cover tipping for guides, drivers, etc. In Jordan, tips are not prepaid.

Fuel Surcharges, Fees or Taxes

It is possible that the ground, vehicles, governments, visa providers or facilitators, and other operators will bill LP for additional fuel surcharges, fees, and or other taxes. You will be notified quickly and prior to being billed for final payment if any vendors make any of these types of increases. You may arrange your own air travel.

Currency and Special Provisions

Pricing of tour and event was based on the currency that was in effect on November 15, 2023. You will be notified as far in advance as possible in the event the price of the tour needs to be adjusted. We do not foresee this happening, but in today's economic climate, we have to be prepared for any currency discontinuation or devaluation, or "reset" that can affect any of the countries we visit, transit, or to which we provide governance. We will do everything possible to not allow this to happen, but we have to be mindful of the world's current political environment.

Safety

The safety of passengers is a primary concern of LP but also of the owners and operators of the vessels, aircraft, camps, resorts, ground transportation, and other facilities being used. If safety is threatened by any factors the owners/operators of other facilities and services reserve the right to make whatever changes to the itinerary or schedule they deem necessary for the safety of all. In the event of danger or war, we will do all possible to facilitate a change of dates, destinations, and vendor refunds. It all depends on timing and geography. There is never a set standard of operation. In 20 years, we have never seen an entirely negative outcome for a group. But, we do live in interesting times. In the event you choose to climb, hike, snorkel, dive, or take part in any activity, you are solely responsible to ensure that you have the capabilities to perform the activities. There will be additional Saudi emergency services that will be offered in the coming months. This is supplied by a separate company for those who engage in these types of activities. We are traveling to Jabal al-Lawz and the Split Rock of Horeb – both of which do not have tourism and medical infrastructure.

Major Changes

Destinations and the sites offered here can be withdrawn at any time by government restrictions and other reasons beyond our control. COVID-blamed cancellations (or any of the new disease-related creations and acts of war), postponements, and such of any kind are not the responsibility of LP. You are booking the trip at your own risk and penalties will not be waived. If LP first knows of a major change less than 21 days before scheduled departure, LP's liability is limited to refunds that we can obtain on your behalf excluding insurance and any other nonrefundable airfare paid or visa fees, and nonrecoverable costs from our vendors but not for any COVID or other named health or vaccination mandate. LP contracts with certain hotels to supply accommodation. Occasionally, the accommodation reserved is not available for a variety of reasons (i.e., unexpected maintenance problems, guest stayovers, and over-booking by the hotel), and a substitute hotel of equal or greater quality is provided. In the event of your hotel standard is being substantially downgraded, a refund reflecting the difference in price will be issued. A change in currency or exchange is not considered a major change. The governing laws of the State of Idaho shall prevail and any dispute may be resolved in the City of Coeur d'Alene by means of arbitration. The prevailing party of any dispute will be entitled to recuperate pertinent legal fees and costs from the other party.
