Pamela Laurion a former educator and a judicial consultant for the State of Delaware, has taught Hebrew studies and ancient Hebrew script for the past 15 years to various congregations throughout Delaware. Because she was fascinated with Mount Sinai and the Split Rock archeological sites in Saudi Arabia, she traveled with Living Passages to visit the sites in 2020 returning to Saudi Arabia several more times. Pam was able to photograph and document new discoveries and teach about the newly discovered inscriptions and artifacts. Recently Pam's discoveries at these sites were presented to a team at The Museum of the Bible in Washington D.C. and for the past 3 years, she has traveled and presented her experiences nationwide.
