WHY DID YESHUA WEEP?

*The reference for this story is found in John 11.

*This was the last recorded miracle of Yeshua before his crucifixion.

*Why would Yeshua weep when he knew he would raise Lazarus?

Mystery for this story is found in the names.

Lazarus-

Lazarus is the Greek name for the Hebrew name Elazar or Eleazar. Strong's # H410

Who was Eleazar?

He was the second high priest of Israel. The high priest is a type and shadow of Messiah.

Lazarus- type and shadow of the high priest Messiah

*Mary- meaning to despoil/rob. The Greek for the name Miriam.

*Martha- of Chaldean origin.

Meaning mistress. It is the Greek form of Mary/Merari.

Mary - House of Judah Martha- House of Israel

Lazarus - High Priest Messiah Mary- House of Judah Martha- House of Israel Jews- Those unsaved and saved Pharisees and Sadducees-The council of Satan, den of vipers.

John 11:1-2

- ¹⁾ Now a certain man was sick, named Lazarus (Yeshua high priest), of Bethany, the town of Mary (House of Judah) and her sister Martha (House of Israel).
- ²⁾ It was that Mary (House of Judah) which anointed the Lord with ointment, and wiped his feet with her hair, whose brother Lazarus (Hight Priest Yeshua) was sick.

John 11:3-4

- 3) Therefore his sisters sent unto him, saying, Lord, behold, he whom thou loves is sick.
- 4) When Yeshua heard that, he said, this sickness is not unto death, but for the glory of God, that the Son of God might be glorified thereby.

John 11:5-6

- ⁵⁾ Now Yeshua loved Martha (House of Israel), and her sister, and Lazarus (High Priest Yeshua)
- 6) When he heard therefore that he was sick, he abode two days still in the same place he was.

John 11:7-8

- ⁷⁾ Then after that saith he unto his disciples, Let us go into Judaea again.
- 8) His disciples say unto him, Master, the Jews of late sought to stone thee; and goest thou thither again?

John 11:9-10

- ⁹⁾ Yeshua answered, Are there not twelve hours in a day? If any man walk in the day, he stumbleth not, because he seeth the light of this world.
 - ¹⁰⁾ But if a man walk in the night, he stumbleth, because there is no light in him.

John 11:11-12

- 11) These things said he: and after that he saith unto them, Our friend Lazarus (High Priest Yeshua) sleepeth; but I go, that I may awake him out of sleep.
 - ¹²⁾ then said his disciples, Lord, if he sleep, he shall do well.

John 11:13-14

Howbeit Yeshua spake of his death: but they thought that he had spoken of taking of rest in sleep.
 Then said Yeshua into them plainly, Lazarus (High Priest Yeshua) is dead.

John 11:15-16

- ¹⁵⁾ And I am glad for your sakes that I was not there, to the intent he may believe; nevertheless let us go unto him.
- ¹⁶⁾ Then said Thomas, which is called Didymus, unto his fellow disciples, Let us also go, that we may die with him.

John 11:17-18

¹⁷⁾ Then when Yeshua came, he found that he had lain in the grave four days already.

¹⁸⁾ now Bethany was nigh unto Jerusalem, about fifteen furlongs off:

John 11:19-20

- (House of Israel) and Mary (House of Judah) to comfort them concerning their brother.
 - ²⁰⁾ Then Martha (House of Israel), as soon as she heard that Yeshua was coming, went and met him; but Mary (House of Judah) sat still in the house.

John 11:21-22

Then said Martha (House of Israel) unto Yeshua, Lord, if thou hath been here, my brother had not died.
 But I know, that even now, whatsoever thou wilt ask of God, God will give it to thee.

John 11:23-24

- ²³⁾ Yeshua saith unto her, Thy brother shall rise again.
- ²⁴⁾ Martha (House of Israel) saith unto him, I know that he shall rise again in the resurrection at the last day.

John 11:25-26

- ²⁵⁾ Yeshua said unto her, I am the resurrection and the life, he that believe that in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live:
- ²⁶⁾ and whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die. Believe thou this?

John 11:27-28

²⁷⁾ She saith unto him, yea, Lord: I believe that thou art the Christ, the Son of God, which come into the world.
²⁸⁾ and when she had so said, she went her way, and called Mary (House of Judah) her sister secretly, saying, The Master is come, and calleth for thee.

John 11:29-30

²⁹⁾ As soon as she heard that, she arose quickly, and came unto him.
³⁰⁾ Now Yeshua was not yet come into the town, but was in that place where Martha (House of Israel) met him.

John 11:31-32

31) The Jews (unbelievers) then which were with her in the house, and comforted her, when they saw Mary (House of Judah), that she rose up hastily and went out, followed her, saying, She goeth unto the grave to weep there. 32) Then when Mary (House of Judah) was come where Yeshua was and saw him, she fell down at his feet, saying unto him, Lord, if thou hadst been here my brother had not died.

John 11:33-34

When Yeshua therefore saw her weeping, and the Jews (unbelievers) also weeping which came with her, he groaned in the spirit, and was troubled.
And said, Where have he laid him? they said unto him, Lord, come and see.

John 11:35

35) Yeshua wept.

John 11:36-37

- ³⁶⁾ Then said the Jews, Behold how he loved him!
- ³⁷⁾ And some of them said, Could not this man, which opened the eyes of the blind, have caused that even this man should not have died?

John 11:38-39

- ³⁸⁾ Yeshua therefore again groaning in himself cometh to the grave. It was a cave, and a stone lay upon it.
- ³⁹⁾ Yeshua said, Take ye away the stone. Martha (House of Israel), the sister of him that was dead, saith unto him, Lord, by this time he stinks that: for he hath been dead four days.

John 11:40-41

40) Yeshua saith unto her, said I not unto thee, that if thou wouldest believe, thou shouldest see the glory of God? ⁴¹⁾ Then they took away the stone from the place where the dead was laid. And Yeshua lifted up his eyes, and said Father, I thank thee that thou hast heard me.

John 11:42-43

- ⁴²⁾ And I knew that thou hearest me always: but because of the people which stand by I said it, that they may believe that thou hast sent me.
 - ⁴³⁾ And when he thus had spoken, he cried with a loud voice, Lazarus (High Priest Yeshua) come forth.

John 11:44

⁴⁴⁾ And he that was dead came forth, bound hand and foot with grave clothes: and his face was bound about with a napkin. Yeshua saith unto them, loose him and let him go.

John 11:45-46

- ⁴⁵⁾ Then many of the Jews (unbelievers) which came to Mary (House of Judah), and had seen the things which Yeshua did, believed on him,
- 46) But some of them went their ways to the Pharisees, and told them what Yeshua had done.

*All of YHWH's plan is perfect

*We are participants even unawares and all scripture participates in this plan

*His Way and Truth will not cease

*All characters in scripture hold layered meanings and the end is told from the beginning

What did Yeshua do after this?

- the Pharisees a council, and said, what do we? For this man doeth many miracles.
- ⁴⁸⁾ If we let him thus alone, all men will believe on him: and the Romans shall come and take away our place and nation.

⁴⁹⁾ And one of them named Caiaphas, being the high priest that year, said into them, ye know nothing at all. 50) Nor consider that it is expedient for us, that one man should die for the people, and that the whole nation perish not.

⁵¹⁾ And this spake he not of himself: but being high priest prophesied that Yeshua should die for that nation; ⁵²⁾ and not for that nation only, but that also he should gather together in one the children of God that were scattered abroad.

53) Then from that day forth they took counsel together for to put him to death. 54) Yeshua therefore walked no more openly among the Jews; but went thence unto a country near to the wilderness, into a city called Ephraim (Church of the Gentiles), and there continued with his disciples.
