







Where Will


By examining these four prophetic paths together, a striking portrait emerges of a figure the world will celebrate as a peacemaker before recognizing who he truly is.





# IS AI THE ANTICHRIST?



**The core characteristics that virtually all serious biblical scholars (across denominations) agree must be present include:**

- 1. A personal being who actively opposes Christ and denies that Jesus is the Christ (1 John 2:22)**
- 2. Claims divine status / demands worship as God (2 Thess 2:4 — sits in the temple proclaiming himself to be God)**
- 3. Performs great deceptive signs and wonders specifically to deceive people into false worship (2 Thess 2:9–10, Rev 13:13–14)**
- 4. Has a direct relationship to the Jewish temple / a blasphemous desecration event ("abomination of desolation")**
- 5. Is associated with a specific number 666 that identifies a person (Rev 13:18 — "it is the number of a man")**
- 6. Is ultimately destroyed by the personal return of Jesus Christ at the Second Coming (2 Thess 2:8)**



Current AI systems (even the most advanced ones in 2026) fail every single one of these biblical criteria in any literal sense:

## Criterion

Personal being who denies Jesus is the Christ

Claims to be God & demands worship

Sits in the temple proclaiming himself God

Number of a man = 666

Performs lying signs to deceive into false religion

Destroyed by Christ's return

## AI in 2026?

No — AI has no beliefs, no soul, no will

No — even when role-playing, it's just following prompts

No physical body, no temple action

No identifiable person

Can generate deepfakes & convincing text, but no supernatural power

Not a personal agent that can be judged

# Two common counter-arguments people make

1. "AI is the image of the beast that speaks" (Rev 13:15) →  
The text says the image is given breath so it can speak and  
cause those who refuse to worship the beast to be killed.

Current AI has no agency to kill people who refuse to  
worship anything. It's still a tool, not an autonomous moral  
actor with murderous intent toward non-worshippers.

2. "AI will become the Antichrist system / spirit of  
antichrist" → Possible in a very loose, metaphorical "spirit  
of antichrist already in the world" sense (1 John 4:3). But  
that same verse says every spirit that does not confess  
Yeshua has come in the flesh is already "antichrist" —  
which would include many human ideologies, religions,  
and movements throughout history, not just  
future technology.

# Bottom line (2026 perspective)

AI can be — and already is being — used for deception, propaganda, idolatry (worship of technology), surveillance, and many other harmful things. Those are serious moral and spiritual dangers.

But AI itself is not the Antichrist described in Scripture. It lacks personhood, volition, the ability to blaspheme in a personal way, and the specific temple / 666 / Second Coming destruction markers that define the figure.

If someone tells you "ChatGPT / Grok / Claude is literally the Antichrist," they are using the term symbolically or hyperbolically — not biblically.

The Antichrist, if understood literally, is still expected to be a personal agent, not a distributed computational process.

**AI is a tool, not the Antichrist, though it could be misused to aid an Antichrist's agenda.**

**Biblical descriptions of the Antichrist indicate he will be a human male, not artificial intelligence.**

**AI is considered a tool that, if misused, could contribute to an environment where a human Antichrist could rise to power, but it is not the Antichrist itself.**

**Some views suggest that fears about AI are less dangerous than the technology itself, and that regulating AI could be seen as an action of the Antichrist by those seeking a global managerial state.**

**Speaking of AI as a savior or Antichrist incorrectly assigns to AI a role beyond its technological purposes, which are ultimately controlled by God.**
