# To understand biblical monsters-

consider

creation and the sea...

\*In the near east in particular Israel, legends of monsters were prevalent

\*Ugaritic epics tell about the enemies of Baal, Mot his chief foe- the lord of the sea, and other "monsters"- Dragon, Leviathan, the Fleeing Serpent and the Twisting Serpent and others.

\*In scripture, sea monsters are depicted as in revolt of their creator.

Article Of First Mention Genesis 1:21 And Elohim created great whales(tanniyn) and every living creature that moves, which the waters brought forth abundantly, after their kind and every winged fowl after his kind, and Elohim saw that it was good

## In scripture, sea monsters are depicted as in revolt of their creator


#### Isaiah 27:1

In that day Yahovah with His hard and great strong sword will punish Leviathan, the fleeing serpent, Leviathan the twisting serpent, and He will slay the Dragon that is in the sea.

Other accounts of creation...

#### <u>Ugarit</u>

- \*Discovered in 1929
- \*One of greatest discoveries of the 20th century
- \*Tablets discovered that tell of daily life
- \*30 letter alphabet discovered
- \*Tablets tell of creation and the struggle of gods (monsters) in ancient myths



## The Creation Story In Mesopotamian Mythology\*

\*The god Marduk (other versions names vary) vanquished Tiamat the goddess of the world ocean

\*Tiamat is depicted as a mighty sea monster as well as other monstrosities she created

\*After Marduk vanquished Tiamat, his chief enemy, he cut her carcass and divided it in 2 halves and laid one on top of the other. One half was called heaven and the other half earth.

## Greek Account The priest Berossus summarized the creation story

\*The god Bel (Marduk) sliced the body of Thamte (Tiamat) into two one called earth and the other half heavens.

The Canaanite written traditions are very similar Genesis 1:7

7) And God made the firmament and divided the waters which were under the firmament from the waters which were above the firmament: and it was so

However...

# The Torah negates every one of the mythologies and stands in opposition to mythologies...

The Torah is clear that the rebellion of the sea (Monsters) alludes to the boundaries of the waters of the sea.

#### Jeremiah 5:22

I placed the sand as the bound for the sea, a perpetual barrier which it cannot pass, though the waves toss, they cannot prevail, though they roar, they cannot prevail.

#### Isaiah 51:9-10

9) Awake, awake put on strength o arm of Yahovah, awake as in the ancient days, in the generations of old. Art thou not it that hath cut Rahab, and wounded the dragon? 10) Art thou not it which that dried the sea, the waters of the great deep, that hath made the depths of the sea a way for the ransomed to pass over?

Proverbs 8:27-29 When He established the heavens, I was there when He drew a circle on the face of the deep, when He assigned to the sea its limit, so that the waters might not transgress His command.

## Psalms 74:13 Thou didst divide the sea by thy strength, thou brake the heads of the dragons in the waters.

#### Psalms 104:7-9

At thy rebuke they (the waters of the deep) fled, at the sound of Thy rebuke they took to flight. The mountains rose, the valleys sank down to the place which Thou didst appoint for them. Thou didst set a bound which they should not pass, so that they might not again cover the earth.

# Job 9:13 Yahovah will not turn back His anger, beneath Him bowed the helpers of Rahab.

#### Rahab

- \*Name represents Egypt
- \*Jewish literature depicts Rahab as a demon
- \*Term used for the Abyss
- \*Signifies pride and arrogance
- \*Bears significant resemblance to the Babylonian god Leviathan

A wreathed animal, a serpent
figuratively, the constellation of
the dragon



## Biblical References Job 41:1

Canst thou draw out leviathan with an hook? Or his tongue with a cord which thou lettest down?

Psalms 74:14

Thou brakest the heads of leviathan in pieces, and gavest him to be meat to the people inhabiting the wilderness

#### Psalms 104: 26

There go the ships: there is that leviathan, whom thou hast made to play therein. Isaiah 27:1

In that day Yahovah with his sore and great and strong sword shall punish leviathan the piercing serpent, even leviathan that crooked serpent, and he shall slay the dragon that is in the sea.


#### Leviathan

- \*A monster in the sea
- \*Some associate Leviathan the multi headed sea serpent (Psalms 74:14), with the beast in Revelation 13.
- \*Often seen as a symbol of chaos and wild untamed forces
- \*Leviathan has no fear of anyone (Job 41:33)
- \*Associated with demons and pride (Job 41:34)
- \*Arrows cannot hurt him
- \*Has scales or "flakes of flesh"

- \*His breath kindles coals (breaths fire)
- \*His nose and eyes shine
- \*Heart is as firm as stone
- \*The mighty are afraid of him
- \*Iron is like straw to him

Leviathan is often referred to as the serpent...

#### Pharaoh's Serpents

#### Exodus 7:10-12

- 9) When Pharaoh shall speak unto you saying, Shew a miracle for you then thou shalt say unto Aaron, take thy rod and cast it before Pharaoh and it shall become a serpent (tanniyn) 10) And Moses and Aaron went in unto Pharaoh and they did so as Yahovah had commanded, and Aaron cast down his rod before Pharaoh, and before his servants, and it became a serpent (tanniyn)
- 11) Then Pharaoh also called the wise men and the sorcerers" now the magicians of Egypt, they also did in like manner with their enchantments
  - 12) For they cast down every man his rod and they became serpents (tanniyn), but Aaron's rod swallowed up their rods

## Often serpents are compared to dragons

Deuteronomy 32:33
Their wine is the poison of dragons(tanniyn) and the cruel venom of asps.

Job 40:15-24


- 15) Behold now Behemoth which I made with thee, he eats grass as an ox.
