

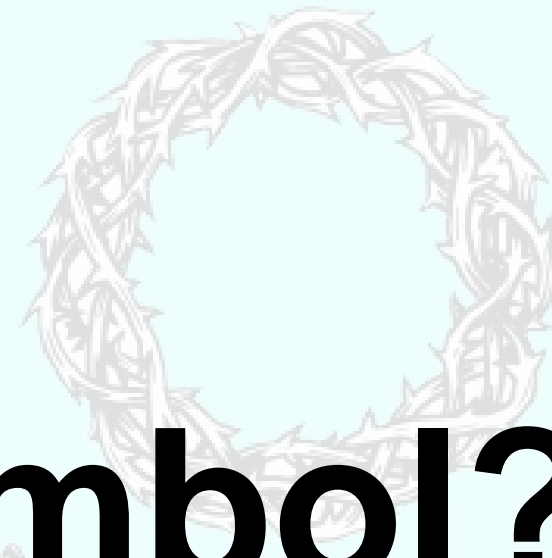


Disclaimer

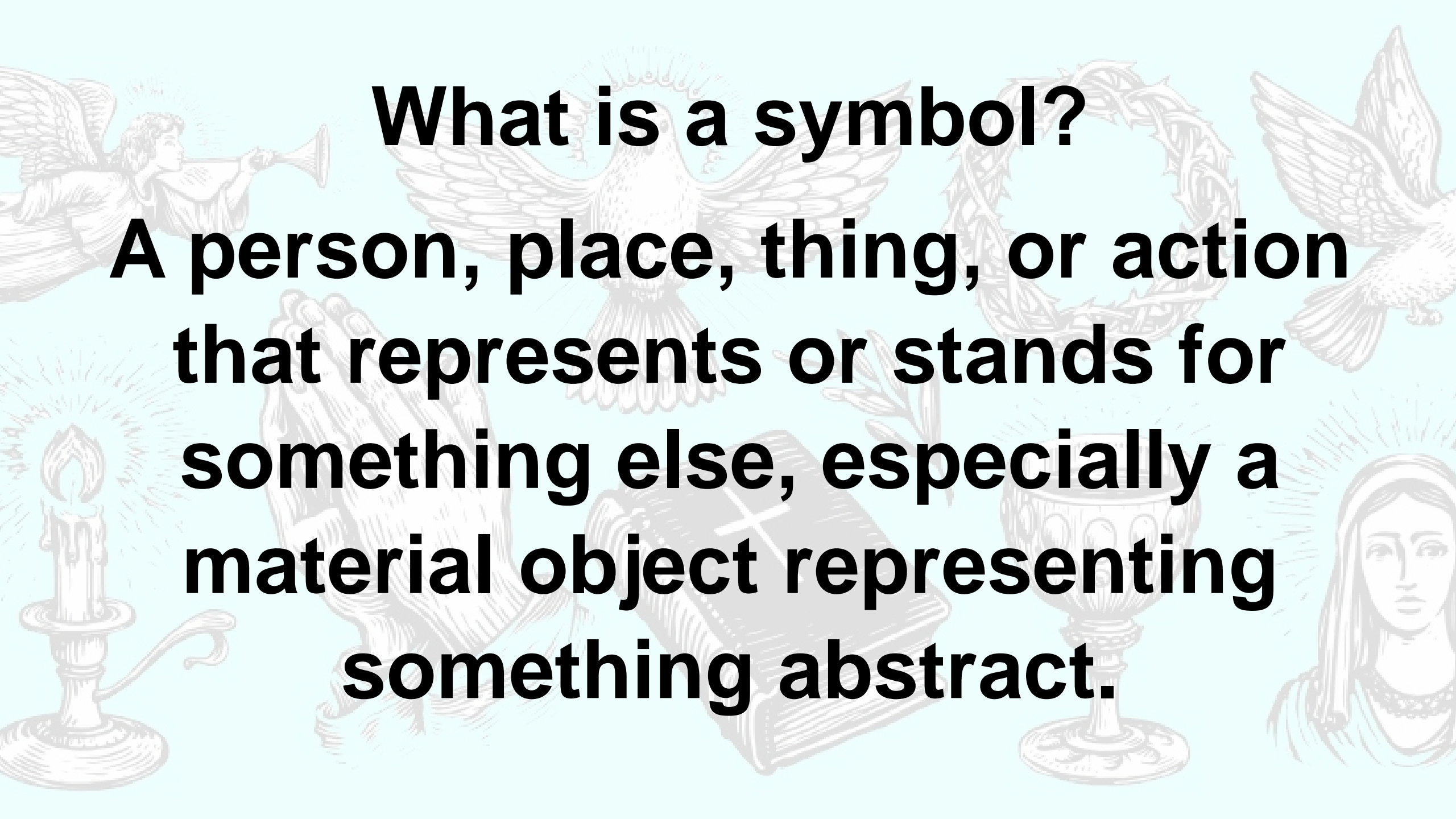



What is a symbol?




What is a symbol?

A person, place, thing, or action that represents or stands for something else, especially a material object representing something abstract.







Symbols in the Bible have always fascinated readers. They add depth and meaning to the messages conveyed, leaving a lasting impact on our minds and hearts.





Understanding symbolism requires looking to Yahovah for insight.



Symbols in biblical prophecy and parables convey spiritual truths and deeper understanding.






Why does the Bible use symbols?


Symbols convey spiritual truths in a way that transcends words, languages, historical periods, personalities, and time.




Many symbols noted in the Bible are still with us today in forms virtually unchanged from when they were first used. (We've grown up with them and over time the symbols have been engrained as traditions). As a result, many of these symbols will be quite familiar to you.



One verse in the Bible may have more than one symbolic meaning. One symbol may have more than one Biblical reference. In no way are all the symbols in the Bible listed here, nor has the discovery of other symbols in the Bible ceased.



Numerous Biblical figures, including Yeshua, frequently used symbols to teach others, recognizing a symbol's power to engage the mind and heart.



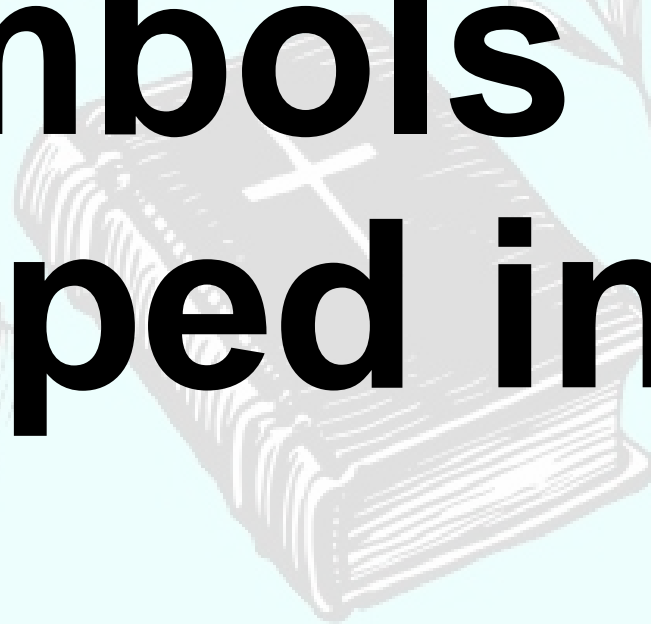
In my preparation for this teaching, after reviewing each of the symbols referenced in this teaching and codifying them, I've identified 14 different categories of symbols found in the Bible.






Breaking a Jar

Ezekiel 37:1-2, 11

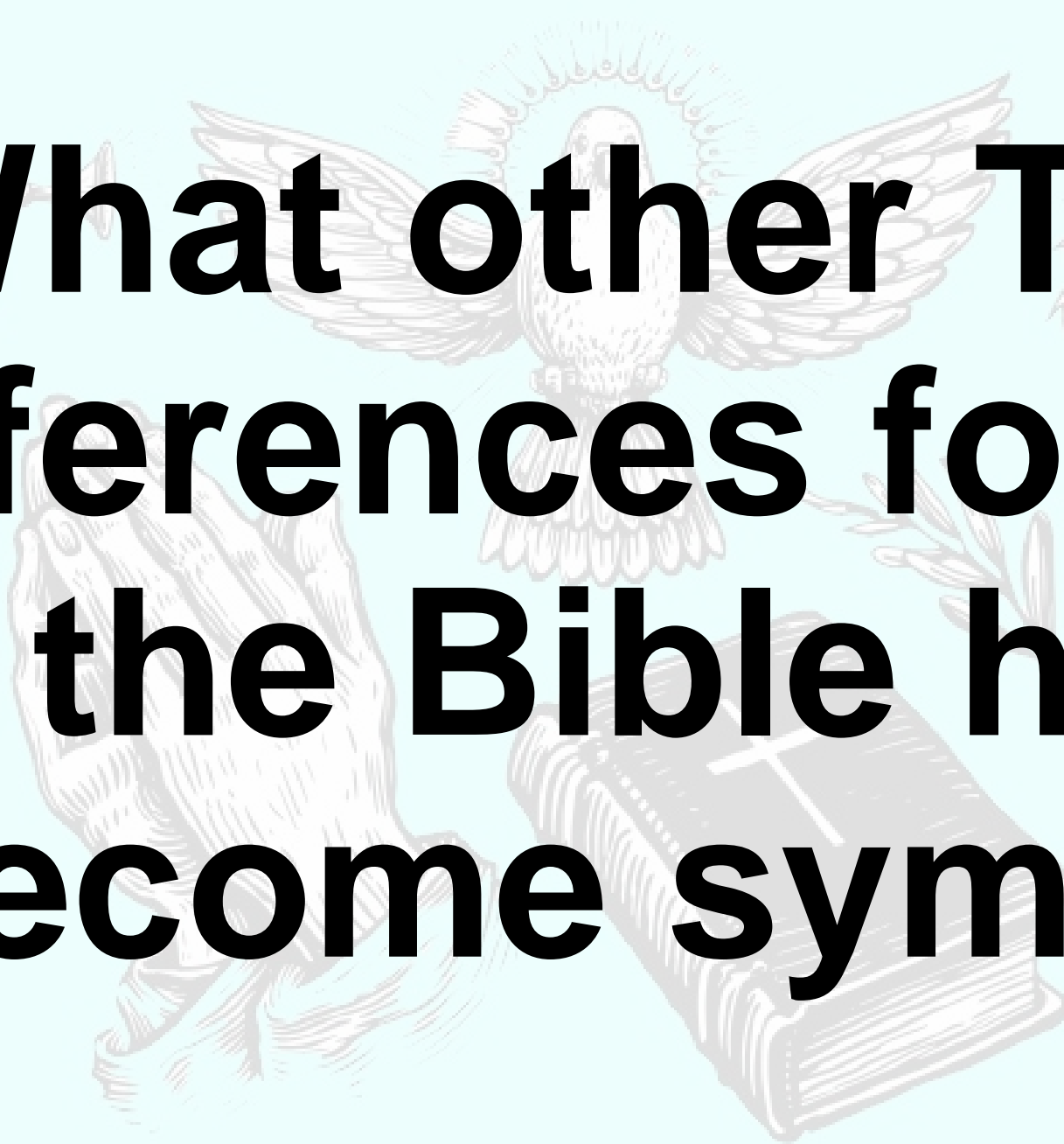
¹ The hand of the Lord was upon me, and carried me out in the spirit of the Lord, and set me down in the midst of the valley which was full of bones,




