16) For thou desires not sacrifice, else would l give it, thou delightest not in burnt offering. 17) The sacrifices of Yahovah are a broken spirit, a broken and a contrite heart, O Yahovah, thou wilt not despise. 18) Do good in thy good pleasure unto Zion, build thou the walls of Jerusalem. 19) Then shalt thou be pleased with the sacrifices of righteousness, with burnt offering and whole burnt offering, then shall they offer bullocks upon thine altar.



Ezekiel 36: 24-27 and do them.

Ezekiel 44: 7,9 7) In that ye have brought into my sanctuary strangers, uncircumcised in the heart, and uncircumcised in flesh, to be in my sanctuary, to pollute it, even my house, when ye offer my bread, the fat and the blood, and they have broken my covenant because of all your abominations. 9) Thus saith Yahovah, No stranger, uncircumcised in heart, nor uncircumcised in flesh shall enter into my sanctuary, of any stranger that is among the children of Israel.

die. So, not unfrequently, he was wounded, or scourged, and baptized with his own blood, or, in cases, one of the candidates was really killed and his blood used as a substitute for the blood of the others. No doubt human sacrifice attended the earliest initiations. But later it was sufficient to be half-drowned in the blood of a Bull as in the Mithra cult,¹ or 'washed in the blood of the Lamb' as in the Christian phraseology. Finally, with a growing sense of decency and aesthetic perception among the various peoples, washing with pure water came in the initiation-ceremonies to take the place of blood; and our baptismal service has reduced the ceremony to a mere sprinkling with water.²
