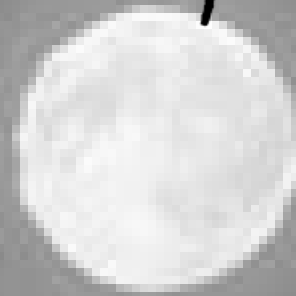


Interacting With Spirits

Part — 2



- Spirit is moving air or breath
- Spirits are not demons or devils
- Spirit must be released either by speech or action in order to have influence of others
- We can have either positive or negative interaction with spirits
- A positive interaction with the Spirit of יהוה is always positive
- A negative interaction with the Spirit of יהוה can only be made positive through repentance
- Even a positive interaction with an unholy spirit will have negative results

Spirit has substance

Because spirit is moving air, we can see the affect it can have in our physical world but very few people are attuned to the spirits around us to be able to actually see them.

Some people however report observing a kind of shapeless form moving in the air, when the spirit is colorless, it is most probably a portion

of the Spirit of יהוה moving...

When the spirit is dark and shapeless it is an unholy spirit.

If a dark elusive shape like form is observed, different than just a dark movement of air.

(like a puff of smoke) it is most likely a demon. Demons have shape and names.


When a dark definite shape is observed, it may very well be a devil.

**Ezekiel 8;2, “Then I looked
and saw a figure like that of a
man. From His waist down
His appearance was like fire,
and from His waist up, He
was as bright as the gleam of
amber.”**

**Often unholy spirits
will have an
offensive odor unlike
anything you have
ever smelled from
earth.**

Ephesians 5;1—2, Be imitators of God, therefore, as beloved children, and walk in love, just as Christ loved us and gave Himself up for us as a *fragrant sacrificial* offering to God.”

Exodus 29:18, “Then burn the entire ram on the altar; it is a burnt offering to the LORD, a pleasing aroma, an offering made by fire to the LORD.”




**Interacting with The Spirit
of יהוה should be pleasant
to the senses, it should look
appealing, sound Biblically
correct, smell pleasing,
taste good and feel right.**


**Judges 6, 36— 38, Then Gideon said to God,
“If You are going to save Israel by my hand,
as You have said, ³⁷then behold, I will place a
fleece of wool on the threshing floor. If there
is dew only on the fleece and all the ground
is dry, then I will know that You are going to
save Israel by my hand, as You have said.”
³⁸And that is what happened. When Gideon
arose the next morning, he squeezed the
fleece and wrung out the dew—a bowlful of
water.**

**39—40, Then Gideon said to God,
“Do not be angry with me; let me
speak one more time. Please allow
me one more test with the fleece.**

**This time let it be dry, and the
ground covered with dew.” And that
night God did so. Only the fleece
was dry, and dew covered the
ground.**



Once we
understand we
are interacting
with an unholy
spirit, what
should we do?

- 
- Do not release unholy spirits
 - Do not rebuke them immediately
 - Know what you are interacting with
 - Speak to the person not the spirit you think you are in the presence of
 - If the person is responsive, guide them into the presence of יהוה, allow them to choose who they will serve
 - Accept the person — not the unholy spirit

Because spirits have substance, they could be considered entities, therefore they should be treated as such. The Spirit of יהוה is part of Him, the other spirits that guide us into a deeper relationship with His spirit may be sent by Him as well as the spirits that correct us.

The unholy spirits will always attempt to divide us from each other as well as drive us away from the connection we desire to have with the Spirit of יהוה.
