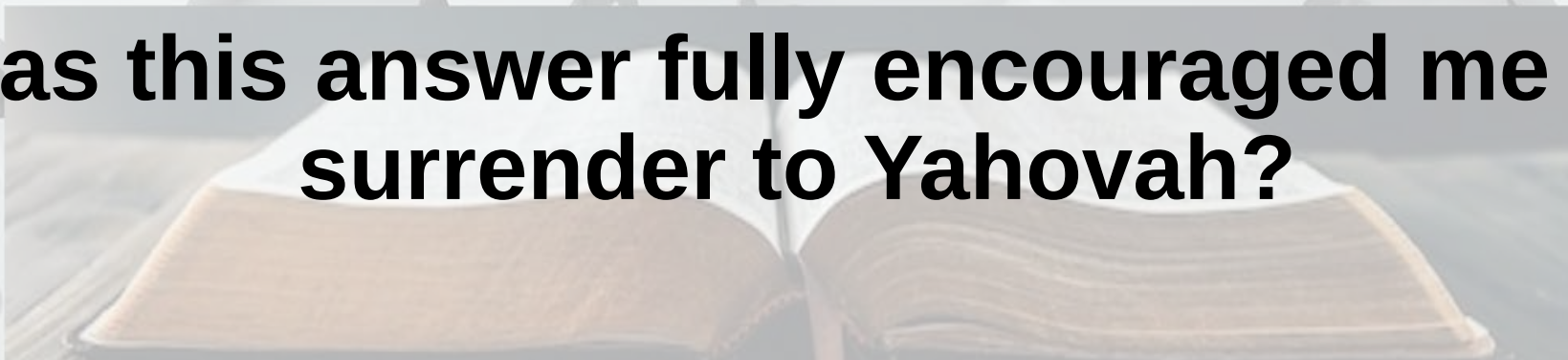
After answering these questions ask yourself:

What does this question reveal about the character or nature of Yahovah?

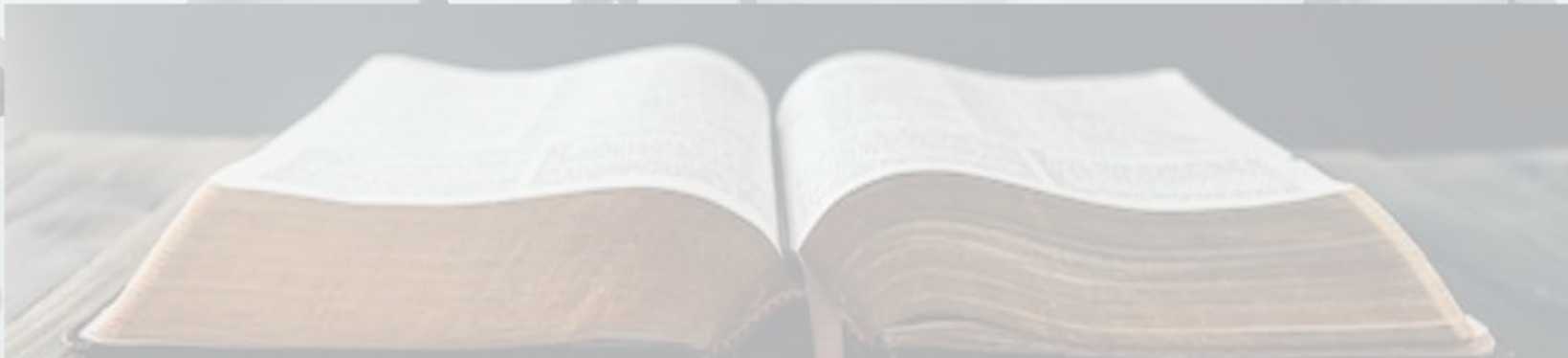
Are there attitudes or behaviors I need to change after answering this question?

Has this answer fully encouraged me to surrender to Yahovah?



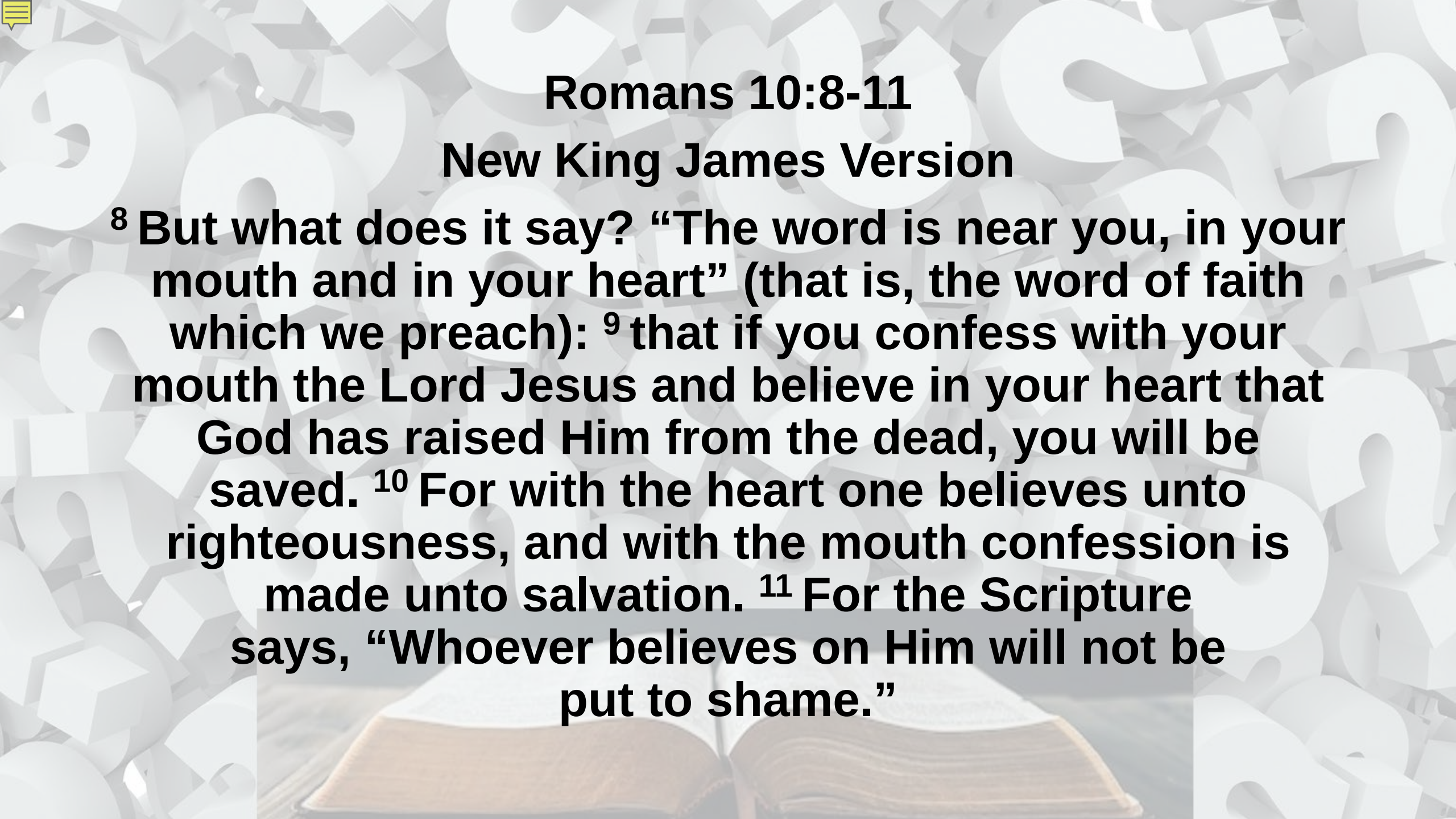

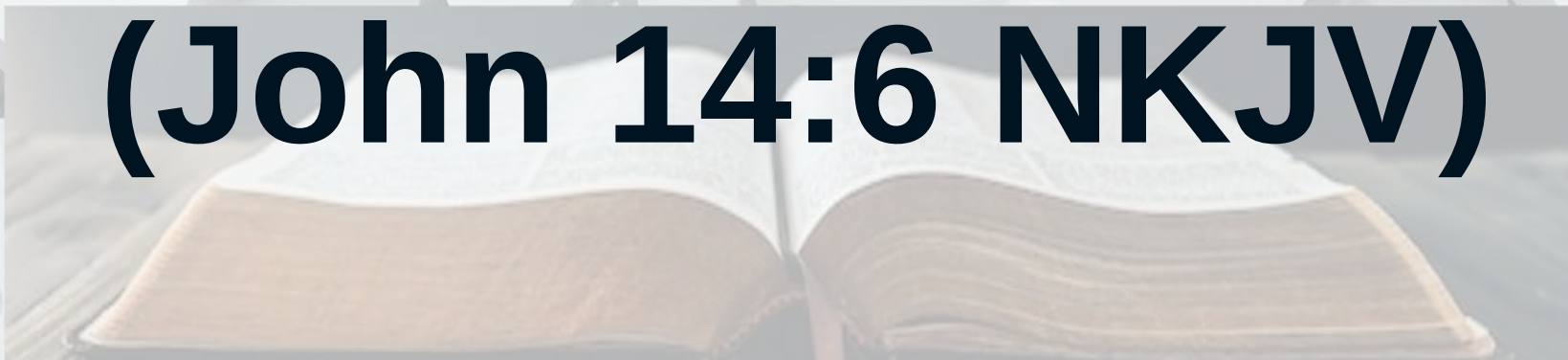
**⁹ That if thou shalt confess

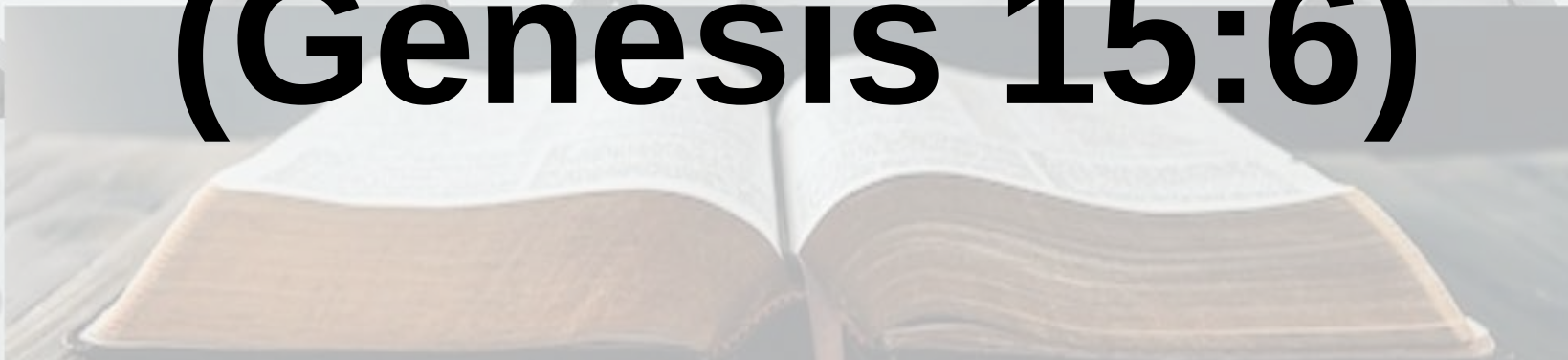
