

Our Thoughts Psalm 139 Part 2

Each verse will be analyzed while being displayed in both the King James Version (KJV) and the Jewish Study Bible Version (JSB).

However, each Fellowship member is free to use their own version of the Bible in making their analysis.

Psalm 139 Part 2

Psalm 139 is part of the Ketuvim (בְתוּבִים) - the third and final section of the Hebrew Bible. This section of the Old Testament is usually titled "Writings" or "Hagiographa". It follows after the Torah ("Instructions") and the Nevi'im ("Prophets").

There are 24 verses in Chapter 139.

- ²¹ Do not I hate them, O Lord, that hate thee? and am not I grieved with those that rise up against thee? (KJV)
- ²¹ 0 LoRD, You know I hate those who hate You, and loathe Your adversaries. (JSB)

²² I hate them with perfect hatred: I count them mine enemies. (KJV)

²² I feel a perfect hatred toward them; I count them my enemies. (JSB)

- ²³ Search me, O Yahovah, and know my heart: try me, and know my thoughts: (KJV)
- ²³ Examine me, 0 Yahovah, and know my mind; probe me and know my thoughts. (JSB)

²⁴ And see if there be any wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting. (KJV)

²⁴ See if I have vexatious ways, and guide me in ways everlasting. (JSB)

Hopefully analyzing Psalm 139 in this way has increased your understanding and appreciation of this chapter in the Bible.







Roots of the name Israel Strongs # H8280 Saw-rah שרה To prevail have power as a prince






The hand that destroys is the Prince (head) with his staff or rod.


