IS THIS THE FUTURE OF MANKIND?

"As time passed and more people across the United States were vaccinated, claims of adverse side effects began to emerge. Several parents claimed that their children were experiencing neurological symptoms similar to those seen among livestock exposed to the GMI vaccine. By May 2027, parental anxiety around this claim had intensified to the point of lawsuits. That month, a group of parents whose children developed mental retardation as a result of encephalitis in the wake of Corovax vaccinations sued the federal government, demanding removal of the liability shield protecting the pharmaceutical companies responsible for developing and manufacturing Corovax.

This type of scenario is addressed in the Bible.

It is known as a form of Pharmakeia.

Pharmakeia has a range of meanings. It can refer to magic, but it very often refers to the practice of medicine or what might be called healing arts. It does not refer to both of these things at the same time.

The definition of **Pharmakeia** is based on the context in which it is used.

In ancient Greek, $\varphi \alpha \rho \mu \alpha \kappa \epsilon i \alpha =$ the use of drugs, potions, spells, and/or poisoning, witchcraft, magical potions. In Koine Greek, especially in usage by ancient Jews and Christians, the word = sorcery, magic, etc.

Strong's G5331: sorcery, witchcraft. I. the use or the administering of drugs II. poisoning III. sorcery, magical arts, often found in connection with idolatry IV. (metaphysical) the deceptions and seductions of idolatry

φαρμακεία pharmakeía, far-mak-i'-ah; from Strongs G5332; medication ("pharmacy"), i.e. (by extension) magic (literally or figuratively): sorcery, witchcraft.


In the New **Testament the word** pharmakeia occurs three times.

(Galatians 5:19-21)

¹⁹ Now the works of the flesh are clearly revealed, which are: adultery, impurity, uncleanness, lustfulness,

²⁰ idolatry, <u>witchcraft</u>, enmity, fighting, jealousies, anger, rivalries, stubbornness, divisions, heresies,

²¹ envying, murders, drunkenness, reveling, and things like these; of which I tell you beforehand, as I also said before, that the ones practicing such things will not inherit the kingdom of Yahovah.



(Revelation 18:23) ²³ And the light of a lamp will not still shine in you, never! And the voice of the bridegroom and bride will not be heard in you, never! For your merchants were the great ones of the earth, for by your sorceries (pharmakeia) all the nations were deceived.

Each time pharmakeia is translated as 'sorcery' or 'magic', it is something that is spoken of in negative terms. The translators have chosen this definition because of the context. This does not mean that every possible definition of the word pharmakeia is condemned. It depends on context.

Pharmakeia has different meanings at different times . . .

The term pharmakeia as an abstract noun means sorcery, magic, the practice of magic arts. The concrete noun is pharmakon whose primary meaning is poison; its secondary meaning is magic potion or charm to achieve a desirable objective;

Its tertiary meaning is medicine, remedy, or drug for healing. The above terms were used from the time of Homer (8th century BC) down to New **Testament times and were known** both to Greeks and Jews. In modern times, this third meaning is prevalent; for example the term "Pharmacy" as a place to obtain healing medicines.

Since pharmakeia is a Greek term, it doesn't appear in the **Old Testament.** The Greek term translated to **Hebrew is:** פרמקאיה Or depending on the font בתי מרקחת

References to the occult appear in the Torah and the rest of the Scriptures, and are a frequent topic of discussion in the Talmud. Witchcraft & sorcery as a practice has existed in Jewish cultures throughout most of history, and was often tolerated and at times even accepted.

In (Exodus 22:17) "You shall not tolerate a sorceress"


and in

(Leviticus 20:27) "A man or woman who has a ghost or familiar spirit shall be put to death; they shall be pelted with stones—their bloodguilt shall be upon them."

Moses tells the Israelites in one the final speeches: (Deuteronomy 18:10-11), "Let no one be found among you who consigns his son or daughter to the fire, or who is an augur, a soothsayer, a diviner, a sorcerer, one who casts spells, or one who consults ghosts or familiar spirits, or one who inquires of the dead. For anyone who does such things is abhorrent to the Lord."



Is The Practice Of Medicine **Condemned In The Bible?**



There are two verses that point to a positive view of the practice of medicine:

"Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick." Why say that the sick have need of a physician if medicine is condemned? (Matthew 9:12; Mark 2:7; Luke 5:31)

(Colossians 4:14) states, "Luke, the physician." Why would Luke's profession, as a physician, be mentioned if it were viewed as inappropriate or tantamount to sorcery?

The New Testament recognizes that healing can occur in other ways besides through the care of a physician:

Yeshua is presented as the ultimate healer.

Both Mark and Luke tell a story about a woman who had been ill for many years and who had seen many physicians, none of whom were able to help her (Mark 5:26; Luke 8:43). This does not condemn the medical profession; rather it describes the desperate state of the woman.

160 million Americans use prescription drugs. 2/3 of all the world's prescription drugs are sold in the USA. **Prescription drug use in the USA has** increased 39% in the last 20 years. Who is to say at what point these drugs create iniquitous patterns in your life.

To Stimulate Visions Or To Heal? Were doctors in the **Bible** sorcerers or healers?

'Sorcerers' were persons able to prepare and dispense potions. But why did they dispense these potions? It was in order to stimulate hallucinations or visions! We must understand that it was long part of pagan religious practice to administer potions, or drugs, which would encourage hallucinations!

These original 'pharmacists' were involved in the black arts and in demonology; the basic idea was that taking certain potions could bring one into contact with the spirit world, and that this was to be desired.

People visit medical practitioners in order to have an illness diagnosed, to be treated for sickness, or to gain relief from illness not gain access to the spirit world! The Bible backs up the principle that sick people should look around for remedies for their sickness. This is a very clear biblical principle!

Lets look at some examples:

When Job was afflicted by boils, he seemed to be aware of the principle that the draining sores needed to dry out so he sat in ashes (Job 2:7-8). Jeremiah refers to the balm of **Gilead which was deemed to** have medicinal qualities (Jeremiah 8:22; 46:11).

When Hezekiah was seriously ill, Isaiah told him to put some figs to boil, although we cannot be sure in what way this may have been medicinal (2 Kings 20:7).

The therapeutic affect of happiness of mind upon one's health comes out several times (Proverbs 17:22) "A cheerful heart is good medicine, but a crushed spirit dries up the bones".

The medicinal use of wine is mentioned in Scripture several times (including 1 Timothy 5:23). The good Samaritan treated the wounds of the injured man with wine and oil (Luke 10:34). Wine is an antiseptic and will tend to coagulate blood, thereby assisting healing. Oil soothes and forms a coating.

The Church at Laodicea is admonished to use their locally-produced eye salve because of their lack of spiritual vision (Revelation 3:18). In Genesis the Israelite midwives had developed obstetrical care to a high standard (Genesis 35:17) ¹⁷ And as she was having great difficulty in childbirth, the midwife said to her, "Don't despair, for you have another son."

Mark 5:26 shows that physicians were certainly available within Israel and we also know that Luke was a physician. **According to the Baker Encyclopedia of the Bible, the** rabbis ordained that every town should have at least one physician. (Vol 3, page 1430, 1997 printing).

It well established in the Bible that those becoming sick or injured were expected to seek medical help!

Again, the definition of **Pharmakeia** is based on the context in which it is used.

Christian believers should make their illnesses known to fellow-believers and to request prayers (James 5:14-16). ¹⁴ Is anyone among you sick? Let them call the elders of the church to pray over them and anoint them with oil in the name of the Lord. ¹⁵ And the prayer offered in faith will make the sick person well; the Yahovah will raise them up. If they have sinned, they will be forgiven. ¹⁶ Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective.

In addition to the physicians Yahovah has placed in our lives to help in our healing, and in the prayers of others, we have also been given the supernatural power to rebuke, in the name of Yahovah, what ever in making us ill. In sickness we have the power to run to God for our healing and not pharmakeia.

Revelation 18 uses the Greek word "pharmakeia" to reveal to us the main thing that will be used to deceive ALL people in the last days:

A well organized system of administering poisonous drugs to billions of people that are not only toxic to the organs of body, but have direct negative effects on the brain. Many of these drugs used for a variety of reasons are known to cause problems with memory, mood, and contribute to negative personality changes.

Revelation: Where Does **Pharmakeia Take** Us?

In Revelation 13, the beast represents the emerging global system—a oneworld government, one-world economy, and one-world religion. The Antichrist will lead the government and economy, while the False Prophet will lead the false religious system and direct the world to worship the beast system and, ultimately, it's leader-the Antichrist.

This beast system will be commanded and controlled by Satan himself and it will deceive the whole world. This great deception will be packaged within a delivery vehicle referred to as sorcery (pharmakeia). Satan will deceive the entire world with his beast system through the use of sorcerypharmaceuticals with a dark and wicked spiritual dimension.

This same beast system (an integrated one-world government, economy, and religion) will implement a mark system—one that involves pharmaceuticals and worship (spiritualism)... otherwise known as sorcery.

This is confirmed in the **Book of Revelation Chapter 13.** Yahovah declares that mankind will not repent of their sorcery. Mankind will refuse to turn to Yahovah and, instead, will harden their hearts in allegiance to, and worship of, the beast and his demonic system.

PHARMAKEIA: The Deception

The Bible reveals (Revelation 18:23) that Babylon will deceive all nations by the use of pharmakeia in connection to "magical arts" and idolatry. "Magical arts" has its deep roots in witchcraft and the occult world. Satan is directly behind the magical arts and Yahovah's people should have nothing to do with it.


Pharmacies mix up different types of poison, package it, patent it, and claim that it can treat certain types of diseases. The main problem with that system is that poison is poison. Pharmaceutical drugs are poisonous. When poison is put into the body it has negative effects on the entire body from head to toe.

These are not just "side effects" or "unintended" sicknesses or diseases that a person suffers as a result of using a drug. These are "direct effects". The reality is that drugs have direct effects on the entire body including the brain.

Revelation uses the Greek word "pharmakeia" to reveal the main thing that will be used to deceive ALL people in the last days. Is it a well organized system of administering poisonous drugs to billions of people that are not only toxic to the organs of body, but have direct negative effects on the brain? Many of these drugs used for a variety of reasons are known to cause problems with memory, mood, and contribute to negative personality changes.

Yahovah detests anything that muddles your mind and makes it difficult for you to accept his will and way into your live. Pharmakeia used in this way is considered evil.

A logo or symbol reveals the values and the purpose of a business, organization, or professional occupation. They use a logo or symbol as an identifying "mark" to the world. In other words, that logo makes a direct link to a business or occupation.



The 'Bowl of Hygieia' symbol is the most widely recognized international symbol of pharmacy. In Greek mythology, Hygieia was the daughter and assistant of Aesculapius, the God of Medicine and Healing. Hygieia's classical symbol was a bowl containing a medicinal potion with the serpent of Wisdom (or guardianship) drinking it.

Satan used the serpent to deceive Eve so she would believe the lie. This serpent drinking from the "bowl of wisdom" is from Satan. It represents the deceptive character of Satan that is still deceiving people today. Should Yahovah's people have anything to do with this deception?




Another symbol recognized throughout the medical field, it is known as the "caduceus." A caduceus has two serpents mating around a rod, topped by a pair of wings. The caduceus, also known as a magic wand, belongs to the **Greek God Hermes or the Roman God** Mercury. This is the same serpent of Wisdom from

the 'Bowl of Hygieia', the symbol for pharmacy.

These Gods are supposed to be the messengers, inventors of magic, communicators to the "dead" and one who protects business and thieves. Many in witchcraft and sorcery still use the caduceus for magic and to cast spells. Also the caduceus in sorcery is known to "restrain and control" its victims.

In the occult world, Satan depicts himself as a goat known as Baphomet with two wings and a caduceus between his crossed legs! Look at the following pictures and compare. Here is the direct link between the poisonous practices of modern medicine through pharmakeia and Satan. Satan is behind this drugging system. A caduceus is actually an abbreviated version of Baphomet, Satan himself.



The "father" of pharmacology was actually an occultist? He was a worshiper of Satan! Born as Philippus **Aureolus Theophrastus Bombastus von** Hohenheim in 1493, he called himself Paracelsus. He believed that ALL diseases should be treated with metals which are poisonous to the body. This system of Paracelsus is the foundation in which modern medicine is built. It has killed and poisoned millions of people.

Pharmaceutical drugs never cure disease - they only try to manage it by inhibiting or manipulating a function in the body that normally happens naturally.

A June 2010 report in the Journal of General Internal Medicine, said that in looking over records that spanned from 1976 to 2006, they found that out of 62 million death certificates, 25 million deaths were coded as having occurred in a hospital setting due to medication errors. The total number of deaths due to the American modern medical system of drugging, unnecessary surgeries, infections, medical errors, etc., is nearly 800,000 people per year!

This even has its own word: iatrocidedeath at the hands of "medical treatment."
