PSALM 27

Each verse will be analyzed while being displayed in both the King James Version (KJV) and the Jewish Study Bible Version (JSB).

PSALM 27

Chapter 27 of the Book of Psalms was chosen completely at random for this teaching.

PSALM 27

The Book of Psalms is part of the third section of the Hebrew Bible, The Ketuvim ("writings") is the third and final section of the Tanakh (Hebrew Bible), after Torah ("instruction") and Nevi'im ("prophets").

PSALM 27

Traditionally this Psalm is divided into two sections, verses 1-6 and 7-14.

PSALM 27

The first section declares the power of God and a boundless hope that God will bring rescue and protection from all enemies.

..... THE LORD IS MY LIGHT AND MY SALVATION; WHOM SHALL I FEAR? THE LORD IS MY LIFE; OF WHOM SHALL I BE AFRAID? WHEN THE WICKED, EVEN MINE ENEMIES AND MY FOES, CAME UPON ME TO EAT UP MY FLESH, THEY SHALL BE AS STONES AND AS BRICKS; THEY SHOULD ENCAPSULATE ME, MY HEART SHALL NOT FEAR: THOUGH WAR SHOULD RISE AGAINST ME, IN THIS WILL I BE CONFIDENT. I WILL NOT BE SHAKEN, I WILL NOT BE MOVED, THAT WILL I SEEK AFTER; THAT I MAY DWELL IN THE HOUSE OF THE LORD ALL THE DAYS OF MY LIFE, TO BEHOLD THE BEAUTY OF THE LORD AND TO INQUIRE IN HIS TEMPLE: FOR IN ALL TIMES OF DISTRESS HE SHALL HEAR ME IN HIS PAVILION: IN THE SECRET OF HIS TABERNACLE SHALL HE HIDE ME; HE SHALL SET ME UP UPON A ROCK AND NOW HIS ARMS SHALL BE ABOUT ME, HIS HOLY ANGELS SHALL BE ROUND ABOUT ME: THEREFORE WILL I OFFER IN HIS TABERNACLE SACRIFICES OF JOY; I WILL SING, YEA, I WILL SING PRAISES UNTO THE LORD: WHEN I CRY WITH MY VOICE: HAVE MERCY ALSO UPON ME, AND ANSWER ME. PSALM 27

The New American Bible, Revised Edition, describes each part as "complete in itself". Some scholars contend that it may have originally been two separate psalms.

PSALM 27

In Hebrew the first three verses increase numerically: Two parallel phrases of five words each, then six, then seven (hinting at completion in Jewish numerology).

PSALM 27

The Psalm is a cry for help, and ultimately a declaration of belief in the greatness of God and trust in the protection God provides. It may be a sequel to the preceding psalm.

PSALM 27

2 When the wicked, even mine enemies and my foes, came upon me to eat up my flesh, they stumbled and fell. (KJV)

2 When evil men assail me to devour my flesh it is they, my foes and my enemies, who stumble and fall. (JSB)

PSALM 27

³ Though a host should encamp against me, my heart shall not fear: though war should rise against me, in this will I be confident. (KJV)

³ Should an army besiege me, my heart would have no fear; should war beset me, still would I be confident. (JSB)

PSALM 27

4 One thing have I desired of the LORD, that will I seek after; that I may dwell in the house of the LORD all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the LORD, and to enquire in his temple. (KJV)

4 One thing I ask of the LORD, only that do I seek: to live in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to gaze upon the beauty of the LORD, to frequent His temple. (JSB)

PSALM 27

5 For in the time of trouble he shall hide me in his pavilion: in the secret of his tabernacle shall he hide me; he shall set me up upon a rock. (KJV)

5 He will shelter me in His pavilion on an evil day, grant me the protection of His tent, raise me high upon a rock. (JSB)

PSALM 27

6 And now shall mine head be lifted up above mine enemies round about me: therefore will I offer in his tabernacle sacrifices of joy; I will sing, yea, I will sing praises unto the Lord. (KJV)

6 Now is my head high over my enemies roundabout; I sacrifice in His tent with shouts of joy, singing and chanting a hymn to the Lord. (JSB)
