7 Hear, O Lord, when I cry aloud; have mercy on me, answer me. (JSB)

PSALM 27

8 When thou saidst, Seek ye my face; my heart said unto thee, Thy face, LORD, will I seek. (KJV)

**8 In Your behalf my heart says:
"Seek My face!" O Lord, I seek

PSALM 27

10 Though my father and mother abandon me, the Lord will take me in. (JSB)

11 Teach me thy way, O LORD, and lead me in a plain path, because of mine enemies. (KJV)

11 Show me Your way, O LORD, and lead me on a level path because of my watchful foes. (JSB)

PSALM 27

12 Deliver me not over unto the will of mine enemies: for false witnesses are risen up against me, and such as breathe out cruelty. (KJV)

12 Do not subject me to the will of my foes, for false witnesses and unjust accusers have appeared against me. (JSB)

¹³ I had fainted, unless I had believed to see the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living. (KJV)

¹³ Had I not the assurance that I would enjoy the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living. (JSB)

PSALM 27

14 Wait on the LORD: be of good courage, and he shall strengthen thine heart: wait, I say, on the LORD. (KJV)

14 Look to the Lord; be strong and of good courage! O look to the Lord! (JSB)
