Psalms 22

- 1) Psalms 22 is one of the most spectacular examples of inspired scripture in the Bible.**
- 2) Psalms 22 is quoted at least 7 times in the New Testament**

**3) Psalms 22 was
written by King David
Approximately 750 years
before the crucifixion of Messiah-**

**Before crucifixion was known as a
method of execution.**

**We know what
Messiah said on the cross-**

But what was he thinking?

1) My El, my El why have you forsaken Me? Far from saving Me, far from the words of My groaning?

2) O My Elohim, I call by day time, but you will not answer; and by night but I find no rest.

**3) Yet You are set apart enthroned
in the praises of Yisrael.**

**4) Our fathers trusted in You: they
trusted, and You delivered them.**

**5) they cried to You, and were
delivered: they trusted in You, and
were not ashamed.**

**6) but I am a worm, and no man; a
reproach of men, and despised of
the people**

Worm- towla תלה Strong's # 8438

Crimson Grub/Worm

It is the same crimson found in

Isaiah 1:18

Exodus 25:4

7) All those who see Me mock Me; they shoot out the lip, they shake the head, saying,

8) He trusted in the Yahovah that he would deliver him: let him rescue him, Let Him deliver Him, seeing He has delighted in Him.

**9) For you are the one that took Me out
of the womb: Causing Me to trust while
on My mother's breasts.**

**10) I was cast upon You from birth:
From My mother's belly,
You have been My El.**

**11) Do not be far from Me; for distress
is near; for there is none to help.**

**12) Many bulls have surrounded Me;
strong ones of Bashan
encircled Me.**

**Identification of these bulls of Bashan
can be found in
Deuteronomy 3:1-12.**

**13) They opened their mouths
against Me as a raging and
roaring lion.**

Let's identify the “they” (vs. 13)

Matthew 27:35-36

35) and they crucified Him and parted His garments, casting lots, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet, They parted my garments among them, and upon my vesture did they cast lots.

36) and sitting down they watched Him there.

**14) I am poured out like water, and all
My bones are spread apart: My heart is
become like wax: it is melted in the
midst of My inward parts.**

**15) My strength is dried up like a
potsherd; and My tongue is cleaving to
My jaws; and to the dust of death You
are appointing Me.**

16) For dogs have Surrounded Me, A crowd of evil ones have encircled Me Piercing My hands and My feet.

**17) I count all My bones:
they look and stare at Me.**

18) They divide My garments among them, and for My raiment they cast lots.

19) But You, O Yahovah do not be far off. O My strength, haste to help Me!

20) Deliver My life from the sword, My only life from the power of the dog.

**21) Save Me from the mouth of the lion;
And from the horns of the wild beasts!**

You have answered Me.

22) I will make known Your name to My brothers- in the midst of the assembly will I praise You.

23) You who fear Yahovah, praise Him! All you seed of Jacob(Ya'aqob), esteem Him; and fear Him, all ye the seed of Yisrael!

24) For He has not despised nor hated the affiliations of the afflicted, nor has He hid His face from Him, but when He cried to Him, He heard.

25) From You is My praise in the great assembly; I will pay My vows before those that fear Him.

26) The meek ones do eat and are satisfied; Let those who seek Him praise Yahovah! Let your heart live forever!

**27) Let all the ends of the earth remember
and turn to Yahovah and all clans of the
nations bow themselves before You.**

**28) For the reign belongs to Yahovah; and
he is ruling over the nations.**

**29) All the fat ones of the earth shall eat
and bow themselves, all who go down to
the dust bow before Him: Even he who did
not keep alive his own life.**

**30) A seed shall serve Him, it is
declared of Yahovah to the coming
generation.**

**31) They shall come, and shall
declare his righteousness to a
people yet to be born,
For He shall do it!**

Psalms 23

**1) Yahovah is my Shepard,
I shall not lack**

**2) He makes me to lie down in green
pastures; He leads me
beside still waters.**

**3) He turns back My being. He leads me
in the paths of righteousness
for His Name's sake.**

4) When I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil for You are with Me, thy rod and thy staff they comfort Me.

5) Thou spread before Me a table in the face of mine enemies; You have anointed My head with oil, My cup runs over.

**6) Only goodness and loving
commitment follow Me all the
days of My life; and I will
dwell in the house of the
Yahovah to the length
of My days.**
