The Book Of Enoch?

Enoch is
Pseudepigraphical.
Meaning it has
unknown authors and
is falsely attributed to
a famous person.

Nehemiah 1:11

O Lord, may Your ear be attentive to my prayer and to the prayers of Your servants who delight to revere Your name. Give Your servant success this day, I pray, and grant him mercy in the sight of this man.”
At that time, I was the cupbearer to the king.

Enoch (Son of
Jared) lived 365
years and would
have died 69 years
before Noah
was born.

Genesis 6:4

The Nephilim were on the earth in those days—and afterward as well—when the sons of God had relations with the daughters of men. And they bore them children who became the mighty men of old, men of renown.

1 Enoch 6, 1

And the angels, the children
of the heaven, saw and lusted
after them, and said to one
another: Come, let us choose
us wives from among the
children of men and beget us
children.

1 Enoch 7, 1

And all the others together with them took unto themselves wives, and each chose for himself one, and they began to go in unto them and to defile themselves with them, and they taught them charms and enchantments, and the cutting of roots, and made them acquainted with plants.

Genesis 1:25

God made the beasts of the earth according to their kinds, the livestock according to their kinds, and everything that crawls upon the earth according to its kind. And God saw that it was good.

Genesis 1:28

And Azazel taught men to make swords, and knives, and shields, and breastplates, and made known to them the metals of the earth and the art of working them, and bracelets, and ornaments, and the use of antimony, and the beautifying of the eyelids, and all kinds of costly stones, and all colouring tinctures.

Genesis 4:22

Tubal-cain, a forger of
every implement of bronze

1 Enoch 10, 1-2

Then said the Most High, the Holy and Great One spake, and sent Uriel to the son of Lamech, and said to him: 'Go to Noah and tell him in my name "Hide thyself!" and reveal to him the end that is approaching: that the whole earth will be destroyed, and a deluge is about to come.

Genesis 6:13

Then God said to Noah,
“The end of all living creatures
has come before Me, because
through them the earth is full of
violence. Now behold, I will
destroy both them and
the earth.

Examine the book of
Enoch to see of the
grammar and wording or
phrases would indicate if it
was actually originally
written in Hebrew.

The Book of Enoch
(1 Enoch) was not
originally written
in Hebrew.

Linguistic examination of the surviving evidence—primarily the Aramaic fragments from the Dead Sea Scrolls (Qumran), along with Greek fragments and the complete Ge'ez (Ethiopic) version—overwhelmingly points to an Aramaic original composition for the sections that are attested.

1 Timothy 4:7

But reject
irreverent, silly

The Book of Enoch (like
many of the
Pseudepigraphic works)
may be useful to help us
understand the legends or
traditions, but these are
not Scripture and should
not be considered more
than myth.

book of Enoch.
