Solomon didn't get what he was asking for

One night at Gibeon the LORD appeared to Solomon in a dream, and God said, "Ask, and | will give it to you!" Solomon replied, "You have shown much loving devotion to Your servant, my father David, because he walked before You in faithfulness, righteousness, and uprightness of heart. And You have maintained this loving devotion by giving him a son to sit on his throne this very day.

The words translated as understanding in this verse is Shama ... he asks for a heart to hear

Now look at what he was given...

Now it pleased the Lord that Solomon had made this request. So God said to him, "Since you have asked for this instead of requesting long life or wealth for yourself or death for your enemies—but you have asked for discernment to administer justice-behold, I will do what you have asked. I will give you a wise and discerning heart, so that there has never been nor will ever be another like you.

1 Kings 3:10—12

He was given a wise and discerning heart, more than he asked for —

A heart of wisdom that would act wisely, be understanding, clever, observant, skilled and able to teach.

All of these adjectives describe the word for discernment but I want to focus on wisdom.

In the morning his spirit was troubled, so he summoned all the magicians and wise men of Egypt. Pharaoh told them his dreams, but no one could interpret them for

Genesis 41:8

This proposal pleased Pharaoh and all his officials. So Pharaoh asked them, "Can we find anyone like this man, in whom the Spirit of God abides?" Then Pharaoh said to Joseph, "Since God has made all this known to you, there is no one as discerning and wise as you.

Genesis 41:37-39

This should raise a very important question—

What is wisdom?

Proverbs 8:1 Does not wisdom call out, and understanding raise her voice?
