***Gates were seats of authority (Ruth 4:11)**

***Wisdom was uttered at the gate (Proverbs 1:21)**

***Judges and officers served at the gates administering justice
(Deut 16:18)**

***The word was read (Nehemiah 8:2-3)**

***Prophets proclaimed Yahovah's message (Jeremiah 17:19-20)**

***Jerusalem has 12 gates named after the tribes (Ezekiel 48:30-35)**

When is the door first mentioned in scripture?

The Door

Genesis 4:2-8

2) And she again bare his brother Abel. And Abel was a keeper of sheep, but Cain was a tiller of the ground.

3) And in process of time it came to pass, that Cain brought of the fruit of the ground an offering unto Yahovah.

4) And Abel, he also brought of the firstlings of his flock and of the fat thereof. And Yahovah had respect unto Abel and to his offering.

5) But unto Cain and to his offering he had not respect. And Cain was very wroth, and his countenance fell.

6) And Yahovah said unto Cain, Why art thou wroth? and why is thy countenance fallen?

7) If thou doest well, shalt thou not be accepted? and if thou doest NOT well, *sin liveth at the door*. And unto thee shall be his desire, and thou shalt rule over him.

8) And Cain talked with Abel his brother, and it came to pass, when they were in the field, that Cain rose up against Abel his brother, and slew him.

Lot

Genesis 19:2-10

2) And he said, Behold now, my lords, turn in, I pray you, into your servant's house, and tarry all night, and wash your feet, and ye shall rise up early, and go on your ways. And they said, nay; but we will abide in the street all night.

3) And he pressed upon them greatly, and they turned in unto him, and entered into his house, and he made them a feast, and did bake unleavened bread, and they did eat.

4) But before they lay down, the men of the city, even men of Sodom, compassed the house round, both old and young, all the people from every quarter,

5) And they called Lot, and said unto him, “Where are the men which came in to thee this night? Bring them.”

6) And Lot went out at the door unto them, and shut the door after him,

**7) And said, I pray you brethren,
do not so wickedly.**

**8) Behold now, I have two daughters
which have not known man, let, I pray
you, bring them out unto you and do ye
to them as is good in your eyes, only
unto these men do nothing, for
therefore came they under the
shadow of my roof.**

9) And they said, “Stand back”. And they said again, This one fellow came in to sojourn, and he will needs be a judge, now will we deal worse with thee, than with them. And they pressed sore upon the man, even Lot and came near to break the door.

10) But the men put forth their hand and pulled Lot into the house to them and shut the door.



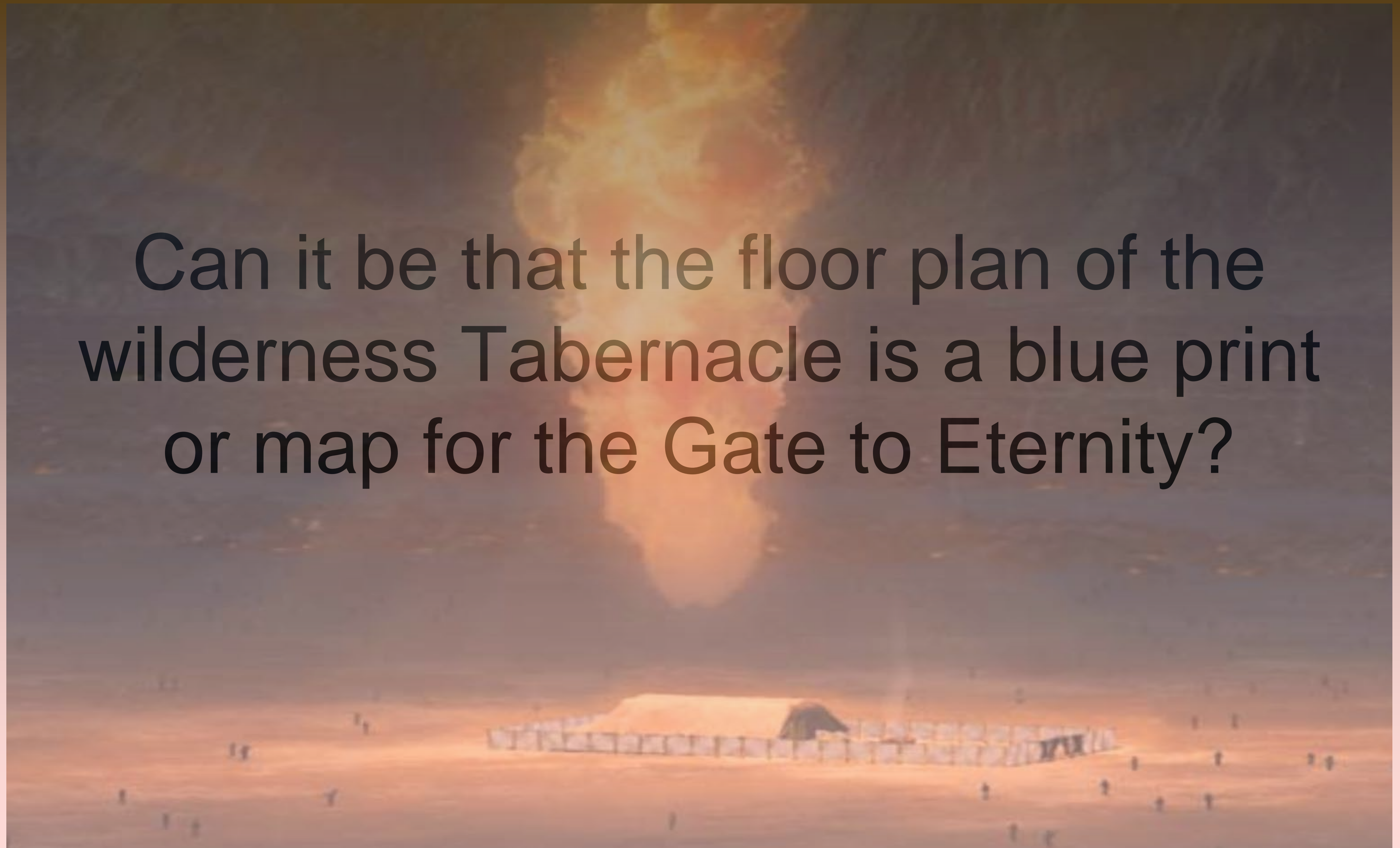
Exodus 12:7

Exodus 12:22

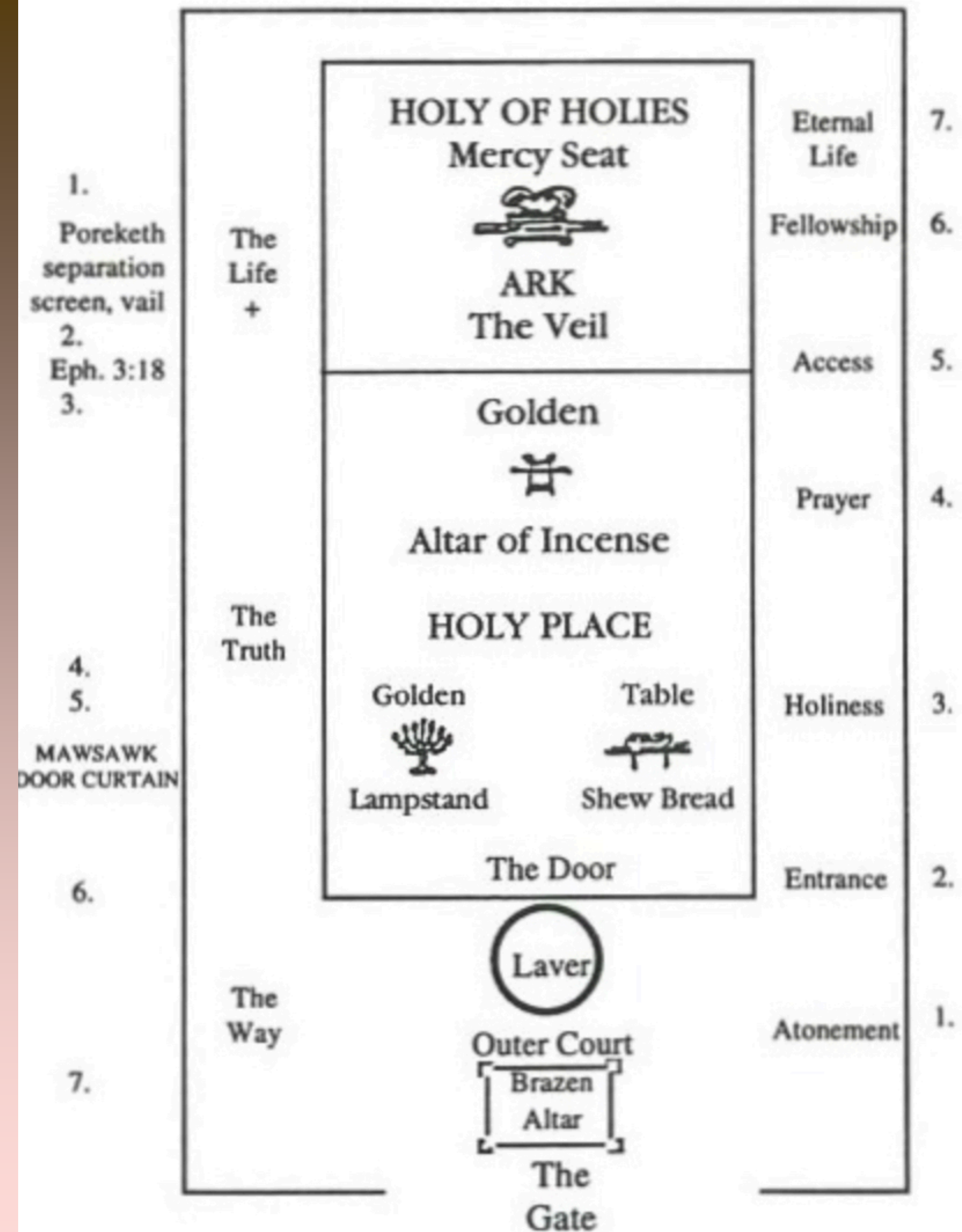

The Court Gate

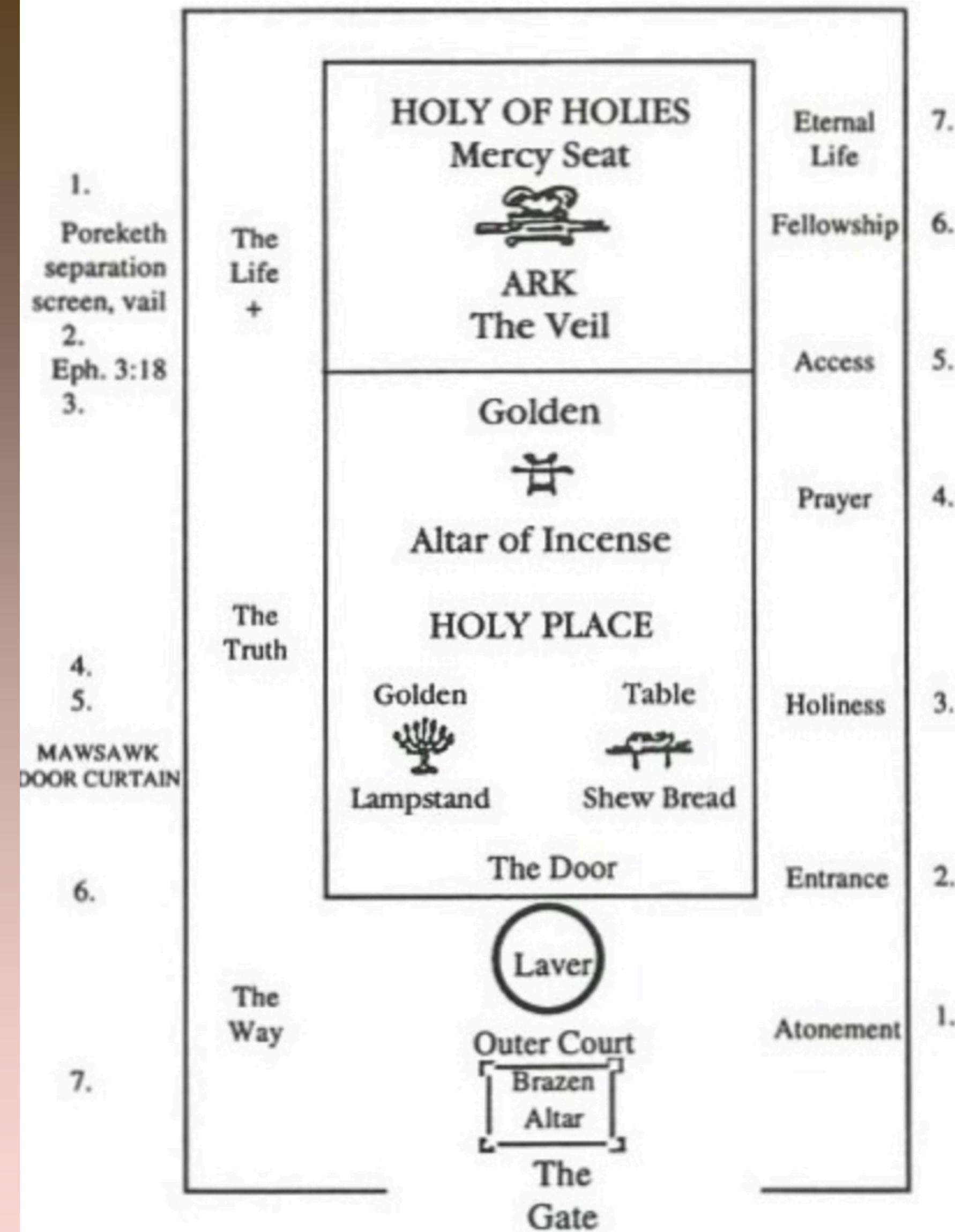
Exodus 27:13-16

- 13) And the breadth of the court on the east side eastward shall be fifty cubits**
- 14) The hangings of one side of the gate shall be fifteen cubits, their pillars three, and their sockets three.**
- 15) And on the other side shall be hangings fifteen cubits their pillars three and their sockets three.**
- 16) And for the gate of the court shall be an hanging of twenty cubits of blue and purple and scarlet, and fine twined linen, wrought with needlework, and their pillars shall be four and their sockets four.**

The Holy of Holies Gate

Exodus 38:14-17

- 14) The hangings of the one side of the gate were fifteen cubits, their pillars three, and their sockets three**
- 15) And for the other side of the court gate on this hand and that hand were hangings of fifteen cubits, their pillars three and their sockets three.**
- 16) All the hangings of the court round about were of fine twined linen.**
- 17) And the sockets for the pillars were of brass, the hooks of the pillars and their fillets of silver, and the overlaying of their chapters of silver and all the pillars of the court were filleted with silver**



2 Esdras 7:3-14
