*** I believe prophecy is given so that we are NOT to predict the future but to understand the future when it happens.**

*** This view of the future of Yahovah's people is where I stand at this moment.**

*** My understanding on this subject can change.**

*** First known reference to the idea of rapture may have appeared in two obscure but contestable sentences from a 4th century A.D. 1500 word sermon written in Latin by someone called “Pseudo Ephraim”.**

*** This idea remained unknown for 14 centuries.**

*** In the 18th century only slight and vague mentions of it have been published in the writings of a famous Calvinist theologian John Gill (1748) and Morgan Edwards (1788).**

*** The history of rapture is only about 200 years old launched around 1830 by a group of Plymouth Brethren in Scotland under the direction of John Darby 1800-1882.**

*** Between 1800-1882 John Darby began to hold
Prophetic Conferences.**

During one of these conferences a supposed “prophetic word” came from the Lord through a young 15 year old Scottish girl named Margaret Macdonald. While in a trance she received a private vision and revelation that only a select group of believers would be removed from the earth before the days of the Antichrist.

*** She also saw believers enduring the tribulation - something most rapturists nowadays do not teach.**

- * Darby coupled this “vision” of a secret pre-tribulation rapture with Francis Ribera of helping to interrupt Daniel’s 70 weeks, inserting a gap between the 69th and 70th weeks.**
- * This was done to deflect apocalyptic heat from the reformers who were fueling reformation fervor by claiming the Pope was the Antichrist.**
- * Darby taught this theory of pre-tribulation rapture throughout Europe, and then later in the United States where D.L. Moody adopted this idea, and the pre-tribulation rapture became mainstream thought.**
- * The “Left Behind” series cemented the idea of Pre-Tribulation Rapture into the thoughts of many new believers.**

-The bible does not mention a 7 year tribulation period-.

The 2nd Exodus starts with the tribes...

Genesis 48:19, 22

¹⁹ And his father refused and said, I know it my son, I know it: He shall be great: but truly his younger brother shall be greater than he, and his seed shall become a multitude of nations.

²² Moreover I have given to thee one portion above thy brethren, which I took out of the hand of the Amorite with my sword and with my bow.

Judah is given the Scepter-

Genesis 49:10

**The scepter shall not depart
from Judah nor a lawgiver from
between his feet until Shiloh
come and unto him shall the
gathering of the people be.**

Two Tribes-Two Houses

Judah- The Southern Kingdom:

- * Blessing of the first born

 - * Kingship blessing

 - * Will rule the other tribes

- * Judah is a tribe that *must always retain its identity* if it is to give the law

 - * Largest tribe (74,600)

Two Tribes - Two Houses

Ephraim-Joseph-Israel = Northern Kingdom

- * Received the double portion inheritance that normally goes to the one receiving the first born blessing.
- * He will be great among the nations/gentiles.
- * Was the second largest tribe and largest tribe of the northern kingdom (72,700).

The Scattering When The Israelites Enter The Land

Deuteronomy 4:23, 26-27

²³ Take heed unto yourselves, lest ye forget the covenant of the Lord your God, which he made with you, and make you a graven image, or the likeness of anything which the Lord thy God hath forbidden thee.

²⁶ I call heaven and earth to witness against you this day, that ye shall soon utterly perish from off the land whereunto ye go over Jordan to possess it, ye shall not prolong your days upon it, but shall utterly be destroyed.

²⁷ And the Lord shall scatter you among the nations, and ye shall be left few in number among the heathen whither the Lord shall lead you.

²⁰ Then will I pluck them up by the roots out of my land which I have given them, and this house, which I have sanctified for thy name, will I cast out of my sight and will make it to be a proverb and a byword among all nations.

by Ahijah the prophet.

10 tribes went to Jeroboam

**1 tribe (Benjamin) went to
Rehoboam**

Going forward God's people go through many kings. Some good.

Some bad.

Finally God allows his people to be punished and conquered.

The prophets Isaiah, Jeremiah and Ezekiel detail where warnings are constantly given to the nations.

**Where does the idea
of the 2nd Exodus
come from?**

Jeremiah 16: 14-15

14 Therefore, behold the days come saith the Lord, that it shall no more be said, “The Lord liveth, that brought up the children of Israel out of the land of Egypt;”

15 But “The Lord liveth that brought up the children of Israel from the land of the *north* and from all the lands whither he had driven them: and I will bring them *again* into their land that I gave unto their fathers”

This is not talking about Moses because of:

Obedience

Deuteronomy 30:1-2

- ¹ And it shall come to pass when all these things are come upon thee, the blessing and the curse, which I have set before thee, and thou shalt call them to mind among all the nations whither the Lord thy God hath driven thee**
- ² and shall return unto the Lord thy God and shall obey his voice according to all that I command thee this day, thou and thy children, with all thine heart and with all thy soul.**

Is Israel Obedient?

**That then the Lord thy God will turn thy captivity
and have compassion upon thee, and will return
and gather thee from all the nations whither the
Lord thy God hath scattered thee.
Deuteronomy 30:3**

Obedience comes first then the gathering.
