## The Pattern Is Set

**For I am about to do something new.  
See, I have already begun! Do you not  
see it? I will make a pathway through  
the wilderness. I will create rivers in  
the dry wasteland!**

**Isaiah 43:19**



- \* The plan of a 2nd Gathering begins with the blessing of the tribes**
- \* The prophets Isaiah, Jeremiah, and Ezekiel prophesied about a 2nd Gathering and gave many warnings**
- \* There will be a 2nd Gathering of the 2 Houses of Israel and it will be so great that we will not talk about the first Exodus!**
- \* This Gathering has not occurred yet because Israel is not obedient- yet**

# The Pattern Is Set

Isaiah 46:9-10

- 9) Declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient times the things that are not yet done. Saying, “My counsel shall stand and I will do my pleasure.”
- 10) Remember the former things of old for I am El and there is none else, I am Elohim and there is none like me.

Amos 3:7-8

- 7) Surely Yahovah will do nothing unless He reveals His secret to His servants the prophets.

*A very important concept is that Mt. Sinai is the only place on earth that is called the mountain of Yahovah*

# Lets begin with the 1st pattern-

## The Exodus

- \*Many of the plagues of Exodus are mirrored in Revelation**
- \* In the first 3 plagues, the Israelites endured with Egypt**
- \*In the 4th-10th plagues provisions were made for Israel's safety**

## **Isaiah 40: 26, 28-31**

**26) Lift up your eyes on high, and behold who hath created these things that bringeth out their host by number, he calleth them all by names by the greatness of his might, for that he is strong in power, not one faileth.**

**28) Hast thou not known? Hast thou not heard that the everlasting Elohim, The Yahovah, The Creator of the ends of the earth faints not, neither is He weary? There is no searching of his understanding.**

- 29) He giveth power to the faint, and to them that have no might he increaseth strength.**
- 30) Even the youths shall faint and be weary, and the young men shall utterly fail,**
- 31) But they that wait upon Yahovah shall renew their strength, they shall mount up with wings as eagles, they shall run, and not be weary, and they shall walk and not faint.**

# Where Will Those Chosen Go?

## Isaiah 56: 6-8

- 6) Also the sons of the stranger, that join themselves to Yahovah to serve him, and to love the name Yahovah to be his servants, everyone that keeps the sabbath from polluting it, and taketh hold of my covenant
- 7) Even them will I bring to my holy mountain and make them joyful in my house of prayer, their burnt offerings and their sacrifices all be accepted upon mine altar, for mine house shall be called a house of prayer for all people.
- 8) The Lord God which gatherers the outcasts of Israel saith, Yet will I gather others to him, beside those that are gathered unto him.

## **Isaiah 33:16-17**

**16) He shall dwell on high, his place of defense shall be the munitions of rocks, bread shall be given him, his waters shall be sure.**

**17) Thine eyes shall see the king in his beauty, they shall behold the land that is very far off**



# **We Will Be Fed And Given Living Water!**

**Isaiah 25:6-7**

**6) And in this mountain shall Yahovah of hosts make unto all people a feast of fat things, a feast of wines on the lees of things full of marrow, of wines on the lees well refined**

**7) And he will destroy in this mountain the face of the covering cast over all people, and the vail that is spread over all nations.**



## **#2 The Marriage Pattern**

- \* All Jewish brides were said to be “stolen, caught-up or snatched up by surprise”**
- \* Traditionally, the Father of the bride along with the groom negotiate the terms for the bride's hand, and the covenant is sealed with wine.**
- \* The groom then goes off to prepare a place in his father's house for his bride.**
- \*The groom then comes in an evening unannounced and snatches the bride away.**
- \*The bride and groom then retreat to the bridal chamber.**

# **3 Stages Of A Hebrew Marriage**

- 1) Money (Kessef) coin was usually given-  
today a ring is given**
- 2) Contract (shetar) a deed before two  
or more witnesses**
- 3) Intercourse**

# **Responsibilities Of The Bride And Groom**

**1) The bride must learn the things her husband wants her to do as well as maintain her purity for the wedding night –  
(the Hebrews failed to do this)**

**2) The groom must teach his bride and not leave her for a year.**

## **Matthew 22: 2-14**

- 2) The kingdom of heaven is like unto a certain king, which made a marriage for him.**
- 3) And sent forth his servants to call them that were bidden to the wedding, and they would not come.**
- 4) Again, he sent forth other servants, saying, "Tell them which are forbidden, Behold, I have prepared my dinner, my oxen and my fatlings are killed, and all things are ready, come unto the marriage."**

**5) But they made light of it and went their ways, one to his farm, another to his merchandise.**

**6) And the remnant took his servants and entreated them spitefully, and slew them.**

**7) But when the king heard thereof, he was wroth and he sent forth his armies, and destroyed those murderers and burned up their city.**

**8) Then saith he to his servants, the wedding is ready, but they which were bidden were not worthy.**

**9) Go ye therefore into the highways and as many as ye shall find, bid to the marriage.**

**10) So those servants went out in the highways and gathered together all as many as they found both bad and good, and the wedding was furnished with guests.**

**11) And when the king came in to see the guests, he saw there a man which had not on a wedding garment.**

**12) And he saith unto him, Friend how camest thou in hither not having a wedding garment?  
And he was speechless.**

**13) Then said the king to the servants, “bind him hand and foot, and take him away and cast him into outer darkness, there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.**

**14) For many are called, but few are chosen.”**

# **The Kings Highway**

## **Exodus 40:36-38**

**36) And when the cloud was taken up from over the tabernacle, the children of Israel went onward in all their journeys**

**37) But if the cloud were not taken up, then they journeyed not till the day that it was taken up.**

**38) For the cloud of the Lord was upon the tabernacle by day and fire was on it by night, in the sight of all the house of Israel throughout all their journeys.**

# **The Kings Highway**

**Isaiah 35:4, 8-9**

**4) Say to them that are of a fearful heart, “Be strong, fear not behold your God will come with vengeance even God with a recompense he will come and save you”**

**8) And a highway shall be there and a way, and it shall be called The Way Of Holiness. The unclean shall not pass over it, but it shall be for those, the wayfaring men, though fools shall not err therein.**

**9) No lion shall be there, nor any ravenous beast shall go up thereon, it shall not be found there, but the redeemed shall walk there.**

## **Joshua 1:2-3**

**2) Moses my servant is dead, now therefore arise, go over this Jordan, thou and all his people unto the land which I do give to them, even to the children of Israel**

**3) Every place that the sole of your foot shall tread upon that have I given unto you as I said unto Moses.**

# The 2 Spies Or The 2 Witnesses?

## Joshua 2:1

**And Joshua the son of Nun sent out of Shittim *two men* to spy secretly, saying “Go view the land even Jericho. And they went and came into an harlot’s house named Rehab and lodged there.”**

**To walk along, reconnoiter, to be a tale bearer, to lead about, search slander spy, teach to go, view**

# Joshua Enters The Holy Land

1. Conquers Jericho with sound of trumpets (Revelation 8:6)
  - 2) Conquers Ai
  3. Makes a covenant with the 3 kings who deceive him  
(Ezekiel 38:2-5)
4. Kings hide in caves because of stones falling from heaven  
(Revelation 6:15-17)
  5. Joshua stops the sun and moon (Revelation 16:10)
  6. Kills the evil kings (Revelation 18)
  7. Conquers 3 more small towns
8. Joshua *does not* conquer Jerusalem - David does (2 Samuel)

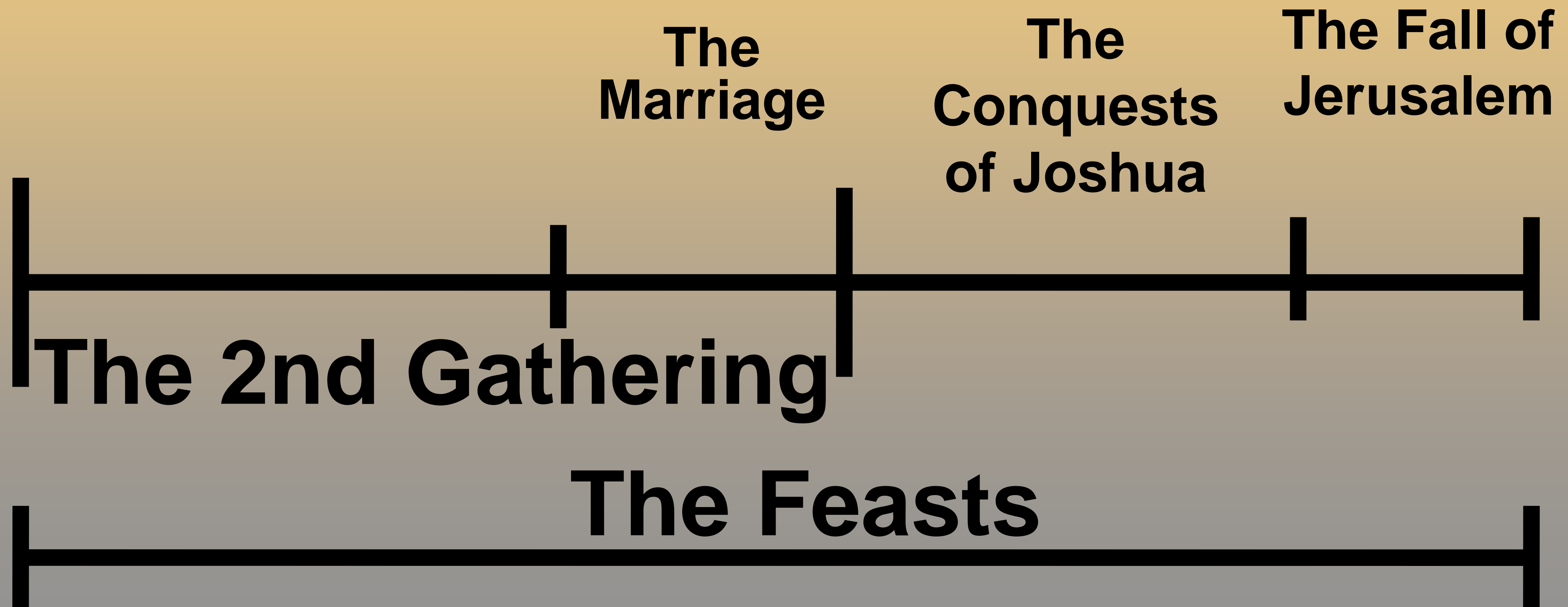
# **Pattern #4**
