
Genesis 9:1 And Yahovah blessed Noah and his sons, and said unto them, be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth.

1) YAHOVAH DOES NOT CHANGE Malachi 3:6 For I am the Lord, I change not: therefore ye sons of Jacob are not consumed

- Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variation, or shadow due to change




2) YAHOVAH DOES NOT LIE

God is not a man, that he should lie; neither the son of man, that he should repent: hath he said, and shall he not do it? Or hath he spoken, and shall he not make it good?

Hebrews 6:18 That by two immutable things, in which it was impossible for Yahovah to lie, we might have a strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope set before us.

Psalms 100:5 For Yahovah is good; his mercy is everlasting(owlam) and his truth endureth to all generations

 - **Psalms 119:43-44**
- And take not the work of truth utterly out of my mouth, for I have hoped in thy judgements. So shall I keep thy law continually for ever and ever.

Biblically define sin?

1John 3:4


Whosoever commits sin transgressed also the law for sin is the transgression of the law.



Is the law too difficult?

1 John 5:3 For this is the love of Yahovah, we keep his commandments. Yahovah's commandments are not difficult.

Psalms 1:2 But his delight is in the law of Yahovah and in his law doth he meditate day and night.



What doctrine did Yeshua teach?

Deuteronomy 18:18

John 7:16 Yeshua answered them, and said, My doctrine is not mine, but his that sent me.

John 12:49 For I have not spoken of myself, but the Father which sent me, he gave me a commandment, what I should say, and what I should speak.

I will raise them up a prophet from among their brethren, like unto thee, and will put my words in his mouth and he shall speak unto them all that I shall command him.





What is the Father's doctrine?

Proverbs 4:2 I give you good doctrine, forsake ye not my law. (Torah)

What is the "New Covenant"?

Jeremiah 31:33 I will put my law within them and I will write it on their hearts, and I will be their God, and they shall be my people.

This is the covenant I will make with them after those days, declares Yahovah. I will put my laws on their hearts, and write them on their minds.

Hebrews 10:16

- Gen 7:1
- And Yahovah said unto Noah, Come thou and all thy house into the ark, for thee have I seen righteous before me in this generation.
 - **Righteous-tsaddiyq** lawful/just

How was Noah righteous?



- Why was the name of Yahovah taken out of scripture almost 7000 times?
- **Romans 10: 13** For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord (Yahovah) shall be saved.
 - **Joel 2:32**
- And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord (Yahovah) shall be delivered, for in mount Zion and in Jerusalem shall be deliverance, as the Lord hath said and in the remnant who the Lord shall call.

Leviticus 23:2-3

Six days shall work be done, but the seventh day is the sabbath of rest. an holy convocation, ye shall do no work thereinit is the sabbath of Yahovah.

Genesis 2:3




