Strong's# H5007 and #G988

In Hebrew it is contempt

Greek it is abusive or
scurrilous language

An indignity offered to God by words or writing; reproachful, contemptuous or irreverent words uttered impiously against Jehovah.

Blasphemy is an injury offered to God, by denying that which is due and belonging to him, or attributing to him that which is not agreeable to his nature.— Webster 1828

yesha: deliverance,
rescue, salvation, safety,
welfare.

This word is almost
always used in a
future tense

David uses this term 63 times
in his Psalms

The LORD (Yehovah) is my
light and my salvation; whom
shall I fear? The LORD
(Yehovah) is the strength of
my life; of whom shall I
be afraid?

Psalm 27:1 KJV

But I, with the voice of
thanksgiving, will
sacrifice to You. I will
fulfill what I have vowed.
Salvation is from the
LORD (Yehovah)!”
Jonah 2:9 BSB

Did Noah, Abraham, Moses or
Even Elijah receive salvation?

Did salvation ever come to
Jacob who was waiting for it?

Of course it did,
Abram believed the LORD, and
it was credited to him as
righteousness.

Genesis 15:6 BSB

Salvation is a gift
that Yehovah offers
those who choose
to trust Him and
believe His
promises.

Salvation is our deliverance,
our rescue from the
final death —

Then Death and Hades were
thrown into the lake of fire.

This is the second death—
the lake of fire

Law (Torah) is/are the books of Moses.
